MULL-ING THINGS OVER

I thought it might be a good idea for an update about the summer activities around the parish.

We already announced that Deacon Bob Cyrana would be joining our staff over the summer. Bob has most recently served as parish deacon at St. Peter's Church (Shortsville, Clifton Springs, and Phelps). Prior to that he had served with Father Bill Laird in Seneca Falls. We welcome him back to our community as he did his diaconate preparation under Msgr. Krieg's guidance. I am discussing with him what areas he might like to be involved in and what groups he might be comfortable working with. He will be preaching and assisting us sacramentally. Please welcome him when you see him.

Mary Olsen has been keeping all of us in touch with the Vacation Bible School which will take place in August (August 9-13) at St. Francis and St. Clare Ministry Center in Waterloo. This year we happily have a good number of Geneva children enrolled in the program and we are excited about the mid-summer experience they will be providing. While admission to the program is free – the cost of each child is \$30.00. Anyone who may wish to sponsor a child, please contact Mary (315-781-2624) or drop an envelope in the collection basket marked "Vacation Bible School." Thank you.

You have already probably noted that the parking lots and drives at St. Stephen's campus have been resealed and striped. It has been several years since we have done that job, and this had to be the year to maintain them. With the school, our regular church services and the wedding and funerals performed at St. Stephen's, the parking areas receive a lot of use throughout the year. Add to that the daily school traffic in and out, we need to maintain them and keep them safe for everyone. You will remember all the sidewalks and the parking area at St. Francis have been replaced in the previous two years. Likewise, last year we replaced many of the sidewalks on St. Stephen's campus. We are in pretty good shape now.

We have also contracted with a roofing company to repair some minor Church roof leaks at St. Stephen's Church over the sacristy area. Likewise, we have also contracted to repair some leaking over the sacristy and handicapped seating area at St. Francis. We are hoping that this will be done by the end of this month. With the work we have done previously on both churches' roofs, this should complete our roof work – except for St. Stephen's School roof. We need to replace the entire school roof – but will probably wait for another year before we begin that work. You will note that St. Francis School – now St. Francis' Apartments received a new roof last year when it became the property of the Geneva Housing Authority.

We are currently seeking bids for the replacement of the outside wall of the Daily Mass Chapel and the windowed outside wall of the Parish Center. We are hoping to get that done before winter but will have to review the bids and then contract for that work. As many of you know, contractors are very busy this summer and into the Fall, so, it will be done when they can do it. This is preventive maintenance – get it done before we have any big problems with it. Rebecca and the Finance Committee have budgeted for all these updates.

Along with these we have begun installing a permanent livestreaming system in St. Francis Church. We have run wires to establish proper connections and will be installing cameras and a master control system. Once this is done. Father Carlos will no longer need to keep setting up his telephone to provide the livestream on Facebook. It is our hope to install a similar livestreaming system at St. Stephen's Church next year. This will allow families to also livestream weddings and funerals and other sacramental celebrations.

When COVID hit, we were restricted in how much capital work could be done. We needed to keep in mind that our maintenance personnel and other personnel with whom we may contract need to also be kept safe. We were also hit with many extra expenses during COVID as we worked to keep our people and buildings safe, sanitized, and useable. Now, with COVID a little more under control, we are doing some of the work we had wanted to do last year and planning for added work to be budgeted next year.

We thank Rebecca, our Finance Committee and our Building and Grounds Committee for the oversight and assistance in bringing these needed updates to their completion. We thank you for your generosity and allowing us to financially care for our buildings and maintain their beauty as well as their functionality. Have a good week and give yourself some free time to enjoy these summer days!

From Deacon Bob Cyrana

Greetings in Christ! I am Deacon Bob Cyrana, recently assigned by Bishop Matano to Our Lady of Peace Parish and I'm happy to be finally home. It might sound strange for a newly assigned deacon to say they are happy to be finally home but let me explain. I was born and raised in Rochester and moved to Geneva in the early 1980's. My wife Cecelia and I were married at St. Stephen's Church. We have five children, eight grandchildren, and one great-grandchild. During our time here we were both very active in the parish. I was part of the RCIA Core Team, served as an extra ordinary minister of Communion, and attended all the bible study groups led by Deacon Mike Mahoney and Father Mike McHale. Once I was asked to teach the 6th grade class for religious instruction. Seeing that I was a former Army Officer serving as commander to four different units during my army career I thought it would be easy to teach six graders. Nothing could be further from the truth and my teaching was a disaster. God bless all our Religious Education teachers. One Sunday in 1994, the pastor, Monsignor Gerard Krieg, asked me to consider applying for the permanent diaconate. I applied, was accepted to formation, and was ordained a permanent deacon on June 12, 1999. Since my ordination I have served throughout the diocese assisting at many different ministries and parishes. I even returned to Geneva occasionally to help Father Roy Kiggins when he was pastor here by officiating at many of the destination marriages. I look forward to reacquainting with old friends and meeting new friends at Our Lady of Peace Parish.



Dios Es Más que una Idea o Doctrina

Recientemente yo estaba hablando a un hombre y le pregunté qué estaba haciendo para ayudar a sus hijos crecer en la fe. El me dijo que ellos estaban aprendiendo la doctrina. Pero, piénsalo: doctrina es un conjunto de enseñanzas, verdades sobre Dios o dogmas que la Iglesia enseña sobre Dios y la fe. Los domingos profesamos nuestra fe al recitar juntos el Credo. ¿Por profesar nuestra fe, llegamos a conocer a Dios y a Jesucristo? Podemos saber de Dios pero no conocemos a Dios por recitar las verdades, salvo si tomemos mucho tiempo para entender lo que esas doctrinas dicen de Dios por entrar en reflexión y oración sobre ellos. Nuestra fe en Dios tiene que ser más que una lista de creencias. Tenemos que llegar a conocer y formar una relación con Dios. Dios es mucho más que una doctrina.

Cuando los esposos se vieron por primera vez, quizás alguien les dijo los nombres y que fueron hijos de Juan y María y hermano de Luis y Gertrudis, etc. En otra tiempo otra persona los presentó uno al otro y tuvieron la posibilidad de conversar. Al ver que tenían algo en comun, empezaron a verse más y salir juntos. Eventualmente empezaron a sentir un sentimiento de cariño hacia el otro y una emoción al ver la otra y pasar tiempo juntos. El amor creció no solamente por saber algo de la otra persona, sino porque estaban conociéndose por hacer cosas juntos y por conversar y así formando una relación mas íntima.

No vamos a poder realmente amar a Dios si Dios sea solamente una doctrina o concepto. Debemos relacionarnos con Dios por medio de conversación u oración íntima, por leer y reflexionar sobre las Sagradas Escrituras, por escribirle cartas y mensajes, por escuchar a otras personas hablar de su relación con Dios, y por caminar, pasar por y admirar su creación. Así van a poder encontrar al Dios de amor, de paz, de compasión, de la creación e imaginación, de la justicia, de la luz, y el Dios que está con nosotros en las luchas, los sufrimientos y las alegrías. Y así vamos a descubrir la presencia y acción del Espíritu Santo moviéndonos, inspirándonos e impulsándonos a actuar desde adentro.

Dios es vivo. Otras personas pueden mostrarnos cómo es Dios por la manera que aceptan a todos como hermanos, cómo sirven a los demás y cómo viven su fe—sí en oración pero también en acciones de servicio, de compasión, de preocupación, de presencia, de justicia y de paz. Juntos como comunidad, como el pueblo de Dios recibimos la fuerza los domingos para poder vivir una vida de seguimiento de Cristo y acción cristiana en el mundo. Cristo se hace presente por medio de otras personas y ojalá reflejemos a Cristo a los demás.

¿En tu vida ya estás formando una relación con Dios? ¿Estás mostrando a Dios vivo a otras personas? Adelante vamos para ser más cristiano(a) cada día. Estamos en el camino juntos como hermanos(as).
