### MULL-ING THINGS OVER

Currently, we are registering new students for St. Francis-St. Stephen School. We recently had an Open House inviting prospective parents and students to meet our Principal and our Faculty and tour the school. We are following up on the prospects from that event. Our registration for this year is at a critically low level. I want to be clear – we are not in danger of closing; but I also want to be clear that we need to work hard to increase our registration to assure the continuation of quality Catholic School education in Geneva.

As everyone knows, Geneva has always had a very strong commitment to Catholic Education and the graduates of our schools have been major people in Geneva's local society. When our parishes were first founded, one of the first steps taken was to build a school. After the Church at St. Francis deSales was built, planning began for the building of a school. When the Catholic population of Geneva became very large and talk began about opening a new Church and St. Stephen's Church was born, it was naturally supposed that a school would follow very soon. And, it did.

Generously, the parishes have morally and financially supported our Catholic School system. When we decided to merge our schools to better serve our students, the combined names were given to the school to serve as a constant reminder that we are proud of our school history as it continues to bear our names. As schools around us began to close (St. Mary in Waterloo, St. Patrick in Seneca Falls, St. Michael in Newark), St. Francis and St. Stephen's opened their arms to welcome new students from all the neighboring communities. Our enrollment increased and we remained in service to the Finger Lakes Region. With the years passing us by, the number of students from outside Geneva has dropped. We continue to enjoy great support from the pastors and communities surrounding us, but we are not enrolling the number of students we have had in the past. Our reduced numbers are reflected in our financial need (fewer students, less tuition coming in), in the on-going support from young people and young families who turn that attention to our local schools, and lack in the richness of diversity which larger numbers bring to a school community.

I take Jesus' charge quite seriously, "Go, teach all nations..." Jesus gives us the privilege of opening the minds of young people to the knowledge and awareness of God's love reaching out to us in a variety of ways. I believe that Jesus put a deep trust in us that we would teach correctly, prudently, knowledgeably, according to the teachings of our Church, our Bible, New York State standards, and our hearts. Teaching is not a right but a responsibility. It is an opening up the minds of students to the wonders of God's creative possibilities and the coming to understand the wisdom and love of God which is to be used to create a world of mutual respect, love, and peace. As a pastor it is my responsibility to be sure that my teaching and those who share teaching responsibility with me are teaching in just such a way. I have trust in our Principal, our teachers, and our parents as they join me in educating our children.

Besides good will and good intentions, we need action. We need people supporting our schools and talking the school up with family and friends. When someone new in your neighborhood moves in, we need you to share the good news that our school is here. We need the good stories of our educational endeavors to be talked up and advertised. We need that sense of pride which lives in your hearts present on your lips so others can catch the enthusiasm and loyalty. We have your financial support – and are most grateful for it. We do need to pay our bills and be sure all our employees receive proper salary, benefits, and support. And last, but not least, we need your prayers. Please pray for our school and pray that God will open the hearts of fellow parishioners to enroll their children in our Catholic School.

There are six weeks before school opens again. We are ready to open in that we have enough students registered that all our classes will be available, our faculty is in place for another excellent year, our principal is working with a very creative parents' committee seeking out new ways to attract students and ways to share the good news of St. Francis-St. Stephen School. Can we count on you? Are you willing to speak up for us if someone asks you a question about the school? Are you willing to offer one little prayer a day that God will help increase the number of students in our school body? Are you willing to continue your generous support for SFSS through the monthly collection and periodic participation in some of our fund-raisers? If you are a graduate, are you willing to stand proud and let others know what this school has done for you?

We are proud of St. Francis-St. Stephen's School. We have a top-notch, committed faculty resting up for another exciting school year. We have parents who work very hard to make our school the best. We have students who constantly impress me with their hard work, commitment, and love of SFSS. We have you to help tell the story. What more can we ask?

## Año de San José

En diciembre de 2020 el Papa Francisco convocó el Año de San José que durará hasta el 8 de diciembre de 2021; es en conmemoración del 150° aniversario de la declaración de San José como patrono de la Iglesia universal. Es San José, el hombre justo, quien nos enseña cómo tratar a los otros seres humanos justamente y con igualdad y cómo ser un padre.

Sabemos muy poco sobre San José desde los evangelios, pero se puede saber el tipo de padre fue. Sabemos que fue un humilde carpintero, desposado con María, un hombre justo abierto a hacer la voluntad de Dios manifestada en la ley y en los cuatro sueños que tuvo. Estaba presente por el nacimiento de Jesús en Belén y vio a los pastores y los sabios del Oriente adorando al bebé Jesús.

Por un sueño él consiguió la valentía de aceptar la paternidad legal de Jesús; creó en el mensaje del ángel y obedeciendo al ángel, él aceptó a María como su esposa y puso el nombre de Jesús a su niño que le fue dado por el ángel. Él con María obedecieron la ley y fueron al templo a unos 40 días después del nacimiento para presentar al niño y él escuchó la profecía de Simeón. Según el cuento sobre la niñez de Jesús, para proteger a Jesús de Herodes, José, obedeciendo el ángel de otro sueño, llevó el niño y María a Egipto y permaneció allí hasta le fue más salvo. Cuando Jesús era más grande, teniendo doce años, Jesús acompañó a sus padres en una peregrinación a Jerusalén, pero se quedó en el templo cuando los de la peregrinación dejaron la ciudad. José y María lo buscaron muy angustiados. Así son padres que aman a sus hijos.

No sabemos mucho de San José, pero tres papas dieron títulos a José: Patrono de la Iglesia Católica, Patrono de los trabajadores y Custodio del Redentor. Muchos del pueblo lo invocan para tener una buena muerte. Lo poco que sabemos de José nos indica que fue un padre que amó su familia y la protegió y trabajó para proveer por ella. Seguramente José fue como los padres que aman a sus hijos—un padre de ternura—abrazando, besando y jugando con su precioso hijo Jesús. Él ya había tenido confianza en los ángeles de sus sueños, acogiendo a María y aceptando las responsabilidades de un padre hacia su hijo. Así tenía que ser un padre valiente, encontrando maneras de proteger y guiar a su hijo. Como carpintero José trabajaba honestamente para sostener a su familia. De José Jesús aprendió el valor y la dignidad de trabajar y poder comer de su trabajo.

José tenía humildad; él no buscaba estar reconocido por otros. Vivió en la sombra; fue su hijo que era lo más importante. Él vivió bien su papel en la historia de la salvación.

El papa Francisco escribió la siguiente oración a San José:

Salve, custodio del Redentor  
y esposo de la Virgen María.  
A ti Dios confió a su Hijo,  
en ti María depositó su confianza,  
contigo Cristo se forjó como hombre.

Oh, bienaventurado José,  
muéstrate padre también a nosotros  
y guíanos en el camino de la vida.  
Concédenos gracia, misericordia y valentía,  
y defiéndenos de todo mal. Amén.
