### **MULL-ING THINGS OVER**

Happy New Year! This Holiday Season has been fast-moving. With Christmas falling on Saturday, Holy Family Sunday the next day, New Year's Day on Saturday and the Feast of Epiphany on Sunday, it seems we move so quickly from one Feast to another that we have very little time to stop, reflect, appreciate, and celebrate each day! Last weekend, we had the privilege of remembering the Birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, heard the story of the shepherds in the fields, the angels in the sky, and the Bethlehem townsfolk in their homes. There was the mystical experience of the Messiah becoming human and settling in the family of Joseph and Mary – and no one knew. A few showed up the next day. Mary and Joseph had the chance to witness the wonder of Jesus' birth and appreciate the real human joy of birth. This weekend, we celebrate the special role of Mary as the Mother of the Savior and the special dignity we give Mary in saying "yes" to that role. This follows closely with the commemoration of the visitation of the three Magi from the East who traveled many miles following a star in hope of seeing the great miracle of God-with-us. Epiphany not only celebrates the Magi's arrival but the special privilege we all have of showing the Savior to the world. Yes, we witness the Light of the World by being lights for the world by word and deed – faithfulness in action and identification in prayer.

Next Sunday, we will commemorate the Baptism of the Lord and the Christmas Season will be brought to a close. Jesus wanted to serve as an example for his followers by having himself baptized. Even John the Baptist protested – "It should be I baptized by you!" he said. Jesus simply asks him to "do it now", God will tell us why later. The Baptism of the Lord signifies the beginning of Jesus' public ministry as he begins His journey teaching, preaching, performing miracles, and helping people in need. At the Last Supper, Jesus tells his disciples, "as I have done, so you must do..." Jesus' whole ministry consists of one big act of good work which we are likewise called to do!

The beginning of a New Year is always a time of nostalgia and dreaming. We look backwards and see another year come to an end. 2021 was a challenging year. With the unrest of COVID, the abnormal ways of life we live because of the pandemic and our desire to remain healthy and keep others healthy continues. We must, however, get back to living a normal life and re-establishing our normal routines. We are challenged by our faceless enemy and pray for God's healing help and protective care. We also look back on opportunities that we have seized and others that have slipped through our hands. We are at once happy because of our success and sad at missed opportunities. We appreciate the people who are part of our lives and enhance our lives, but we wish we had seized the day of meeting new people, embraced new opportunities, and opened ourselves to new potentials. Looking backwards, we become aware, however, that there is nothing we can do about our past. We cannot recreate it, we cannot erase it, nor can we change it. We can, however, use it as a platform to launch us into our future endeavors and we face that future as better persons because of our life experiences. These are experiences that help us reach our potential and allow our talents to grow and develop.

As we moved through Advent, I observed several music rehearsals – our cantors, our Christmas singers, and our school choirs. These folks are already great singers and musicians working on being better. The music they created was beautiful but because they fine-tuned it as they practiced and rehearsed, it became even better. What they were good at they became better at. At the time of the performance, they were magnificent! They sang in praise and adoration of God, invited us to join in the exciting music of the holiday season and, in turn, helped us to pray and share our gifts and talents with them. We all can use our past selves to be better selves as we begin this New Year. We have such a talented congregation here that there is no limit as to what we can do. We assisted families at Thanksgiving time, giving them a reason to be grateful on Thanksgiving. We purchased gifts and wrapped them and had them presented and many who would have received nothing received more than even they could dream. When asked to step up, our parish family is always first in line to make the step and show we care. No one knows what this New Year may ask of us but I, for one, am willing to testify that I believe in you and know you will be there and serving just as the newborn Savior came and served us. We follow His example.

Happy New Year to all! I join you in thanking God for His past blessings upon us. I also look forward to living out the Christian faith with you in this world which needs hope, works hard for normalcy, dreams of an end to this pandemic and strives to recognize the dignity of all human life. 2022 presents us with many challenges but also will give us great blessings. All we need to do is walk with the Lord, listen to Him, and do what is right. I know you can do it! I've seen you do it before.





## Regalos Recibidos y Regalos Dados

Supongo contentos y honrados que algunas personas reconocieron el significado de este nacimiento.

También la primera lectura de hoy habla de las caravanas que tenían muchas cosas para regalar. Cristianos de distintas culturas intercambian regalos hoy en vez del día del nacimiento de Jesucristo.

Al pensar en todo esto, puede ser que dentro de cada persona va surgiendo un agradecimiento grande. Tantas veces una respuesta a todo esto es un deseo de regalar a otros algo o un compartimiento de regalos recibidos.

¿Qué podemos regalar a otros? Douglas Richards sugirió algunos en su libro de 41 Regalos. Algunos ejemplos son el regalo de optimismo, o de buen consejo, o estar paciente con los problemas de la vida, dar unas sonrisas, el regalo de creer en sus capacidades. También podemos agregar: dar una palabra amable, dar ayuda, asegurar al otro de su oración, el regalo de escuchar con atención, el regalo de perdón; también compartir su fe, esperanza, amor y servicio.

Celebramos el regalo y la gracia que Dios manifestó entre nosotros y dentro de nosotros en Jesucristo. Que estemos agradecidos a Dios que hemos llegado a conocerlo. ¡Que tremendo regalo!
