
Cemetery Guidelines: Please keep in mind the following with regards to our Cemeteries
Flowers may be placed on the graves. Containers must be of metal, paper mâché or wicker.
Please remove all empty containers and trash when leaving.

Flower beds of annual plants are only allowed if they border a monument and do not exceed 12 inches in width. Lot owners are responsible for weeding flower areas. No shrubs or trees are permitted. Anything encroaching on surrounding plots will be removed by the Cemetery Association. Artificial flowers are discouraged as they quickly fade and do not hold up to weather.

Potted items, glass vases, glass blocks or containers, colored lights, artificial flowers/wreaths, or crushed stone around lots or flower beds ARE NOT ALLOWED. Neither will chairs, benches, trees, rosebushes, fences or enclosures of any kind, nor lawn ornaments be allowed. All ornamentation must be part of the permanent grave monument. All of the above will be removed by the Cemetery care-taker. Users should not plant more flowers than they can care for. Users may not dig holes in any lot. Cars are to be kept off the grass.

Please do not use anything that will interfere with the mowing and care of the cemetery or impinge on another grave.

Perpetual care is included in the purchase price of the Cemetery. This care refers to mowing the cemetery and maintaining the roads/access to graves. Repairing of stonework, foundations, etc. is NOT included. Arrangements need to be made with the Cemetery who will either bill for the work or outsource.






