



Knights of Columbus Council 350 Celebrates 125 Years

The Knights of Columbus, Council 350, celebrated 125 years of council achievement Monday evening, June 12th, with a celebratory Mass held at St. Mary's Church with Bishop Terry LaValley presiding, with Fr. Arthur LaBaff and fellow priests and deacons assisting. Following Mass, over 75 members of the Council, including members of the Auxiliary, gathered at the C-Way Restaurant to further honor the 125-year achievement.

Grand Knight Robert Heckmann highlighted several achievements of the Council including the Coats for Kids program, awarding three \$500 dollar scholarships to high school graduates, and hosting three recent blood drives netting over 60 pints of blood. The Council also made contribution to the Nurse Ministry, Right to Life, K of C Ukraine Disaster Fund, St. Mary's Fuel Fund, and the Bishops Fund. Of note, the Council contributes dollars annually through the "Pennies from Heaven" campaign that began in 1990. In that first year over \$500 was raised and it went to then seminarian Chris Carrara. Since then, the Council has supported seminarians annually—last year nine seminarians were supported with \$1,000 each. To date, the program has exceeded \$185,000 in donations.

At the conclusion of the evening celebrations, Council 350 outgoing Grand Knight Robert Heckmann turned the over the gavel to incoming Grand Knight Jack Lucia.
