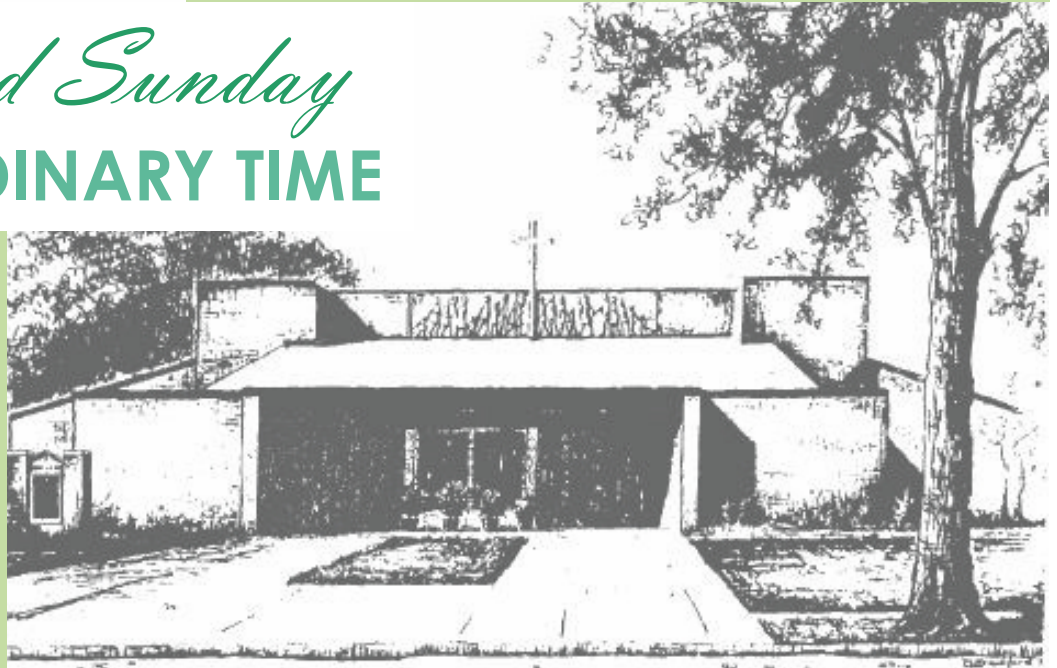

Diocese of Ogdensburg:**Points to note: COVID Clarification**

The question has been presented to this office for clarification: Do people need to continue wearing masks throughout the entire time they are in the church—especially when it is hot?

Wearing masks is essential. All those who are not taking a speaking part during the liturgy are asked to please keep their masks on as they are able. If they are unable, they must refrain from moving about, singing, or projecting their voices in other ways. So, it is possible to allow parishioners to lower their masks as long as they are in their pews and not singing. This is in line with the intention of the NYS guideline. Season of Creation is an annual ecumenical celebration of prayer and action to protect our common home starting September 1 – the World Day of Prayer for Creation – and continuing to October 4 – the feast of St. Francis of Assisi.
