Eight years ago I was so excited to begin Ordinary Time. The Monday following the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord. It wasn't the first time I put on a green stole, so why get so excited? I believe for me it's because of just how much is packed into the season. It's the longest celebrated season, it reminds me of summer, and it's green.
