

The tradition of blessings of homes on the Feast of the Epiphany has been a popular religious tradition since the Middle Ages. Priests would bless the home and write the initials of the Magi above the main doorway.

C—Casper (King of Tarsus) the land of myrrh.

M—Melchior (King of Arabia) the place of gold.

B—Balthasar (King of Sheba) known for having frankincense. These three gifts were traditionally symbols of homage in the East. The number represents those of the current year and crosses

represent saints. The letters also abbreviate the prayer:

"Christus mansionem Benedicat" which means "May Christ Bless the House."

*Copies of this tradition are on tables at the church exits. Please take one and put it above any doorway in your home.



Undies Sundies:

Between next Sunday (the Baptism of the Lord) and Lent, the parish will be collecting children's underwear, socks, sweatpants, etc. These will be donated to the schools for distribution for children. 
