

Our generous parishioners have donated \$705 in December to combat hunger in our communities. Locally Skaneateles Outreach received \$300 where we continue to supply snacks. These are distributed by the school nurses and counselors in the elementary and middle schools, ensuring that students in need know they never have to be hungry.

St. Lucy's received \$300 for their food pantry where they continue to distribute food on the west side of Syracuse. St. Lucy's is the mainstay in this area since many smaller food pantries had to close during the pandemic due to size and staffing. In My Father's Kitchen continues to build hope and change lives, providing food and counsel to the homeless who live in campsites, under bridges and places not meant for human habitation. We sent them \$105. Heading into our 8th year, the CAH continues to show compassion for those in need. Thank you for remembering our ministry on the last weekend of every month.


