# In preparation for the Memorial Day Mass at St. Mary's Cemetery, additional cleanup of the cemetery grounds will be taking place in the next two weeks. As a reminder to all, here is a list of some key rules & regulations:

**The following are permitted:** A single potted plant may be placed on each grave; Artificial flowers are allowed October 16<sup>th</sup> thru March 31<sup>st</sup>; Shepherds' hooks in use are permitted (not permitted in cremation garden)

<u>Important note</u>: All items placed at graves must be flush with the base of the monument for lawn care maintenance. <u>The following are not permitted</u>: Planting of any nature on the lot or grave; Placing of crushed stone, wood chips or shells on grave; Coping, curbing, fencing, hedging or borders of any kind; Wooden, metal, fiberglass boxes, urns, and/or tubs; Pets; Snowmobiles or ATVs; Trellis

#### Important dates regarding flowers and decorations:

- All summer flowers, pots and decorations must be removed by October 15<sup>th</sup>, except for mums. (Exception: mums are allowed September 15<sup>th</sup> through November 30<sup>th</sup>)
- All fall, winter and Christmas decorations must be removed by April 1<sup>st</sup>
