As we reflect on 8 years of helping those around us fight hunger in their community, we can take this quote to heart. Our Campaign Against Hunger came to all of you with a request that one day each month you “eat simply so others may simply eat” and then on the last weekend of the month, (Simply Sunday), you donate your day savings to help others feed the hungry among us.

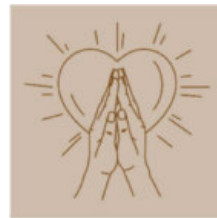
Lead by Example

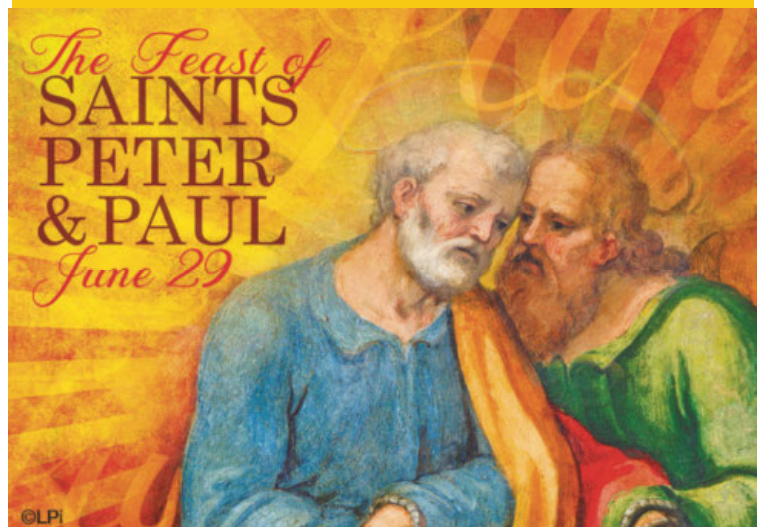
