From the
Pastor of Our Lady & Saint Anne



Dear Friends,

In 2018 when we put together the capital campaign for Our Lady of Lourdes, a high priority project was to replace the roof of the church. We had all of the roofs (church, rectory, school and convent) inspected, and while we could get away with making repairs to the rectory and convent roofs, it was clear that the church and school roofs needed to be replaced as soon as possible.

The school roof took priority as rain was coming through into the second floor classrooms. While we have had leaking from the lower church roof, we have been very fortunate (or blessed) that, so far, the upper church roof has not leaked.

With immediately needed projects like the school roof and the church boiler drawing heavily on the capital campaign funds, it has been challenging to put together the funds to pay for the church roof. Over the summer we began considering if we could replace the lower church roof only, and leave the upper roof until later when we had more money. Instead, we now see our way to replace the entire church roof in Spring of 2022. After paying for the new church boiler, we have \$258,000 in the OLoL capital campaign fund. A parishioner who died earlier this year left the parish \$94,000 in her estate. Another parishioner is donating \$10,000 to OLoL on a matching basis. This will give us \$20,000 toward the roof. Finally OLoL's investments gained a healthy dividend during fiscal 2020/2021. The Bishop has given us permission to use part of that gain for the church roof. All together this gives us what we believe will be sufficient. (When we solicited bids on the church roof in 2019 the low bid was \$412,000 to replace the roof and insulate the upper roof and tower.)

You notice that I mentioned that a **Lourdes parishioner is committed to donate \$10,000 for the roof if we can raise another \$10,000 in matching donations. Another parishioner has already pledged \$3,000 toward matching the \$10,000. Thus we are looking for another \$7,000 to complete the matching challenge.** If you would like to contribute to the \$10,000 matching challenge, please write the check to Our Lady of Lourdes Church with "church roof" in the memo portion, and direct the check to my attention. Let us all pray that the church roof will hold out through the coming winter.


As a point of information, since 2008 all of the roofs at St. Anne (church rectory and convent) have been replaced, and the church boiler was replaced after 2012.

Notes about the Monthly offertory report:



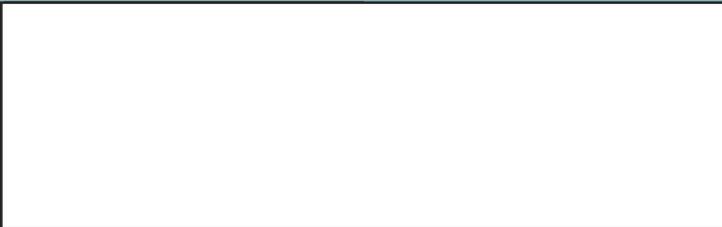
