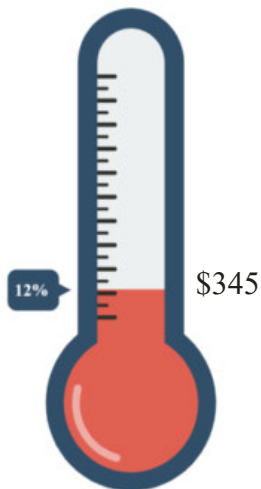

CMA Tracker

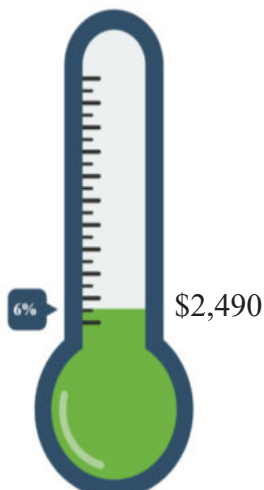

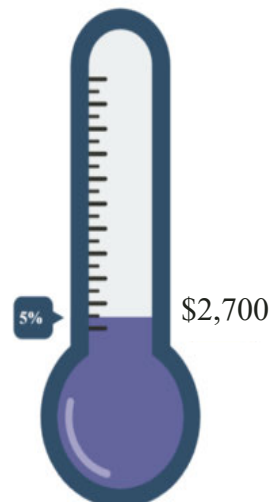
St. George

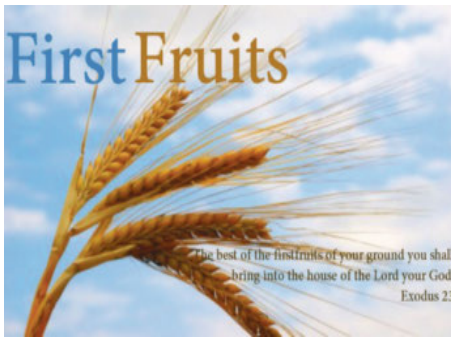

Since 1998, Our Lady of Lourdes has been participating in fundraising and construction of Habitat for Humanity homes in the Rochester neighborhoods in need as a founding member of the Brighton Habitat Church Coalition. St. Anne joined the Habitat effort when we became a Cluster Community.

For many years we supported Habitat builds through the sale of Easter candy and Thanksgiving pies, but the mechanism behind those sales no longer exists, though the **need for affordable housing** in our area remains high.

And so, for October, as part of our First Fruits initiative, we would like to take the next step and kick off participation in the actual construction of a Habitat GRIB house, recently started on Melville Street in the Beechwood neighborhood of Rochester.

Each new build requires an investment of sweat equity, **whether painting a living room, hanging siding, digging holes for new shrubbery or sweeping up at the end of the workday.** There is a task suited to every skill level and expertise ...

Habitat makes volunteering easy. Anyone age 16 or over can participate (16 & 17 with parental consent). YOU control your schedule. Workdays will be available on both weekdays and Saturdays. And you will be working exclusively among fellow parishioners from Our Lady of Lourdes and St. Anne.

This is your real-world opportunity to make a difference for people in need. It's your opportunity to pass on skills learned over a lifetime, to learn new skills and to make new friends.

Can You Help 2 Hours a Week?

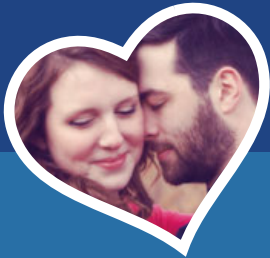

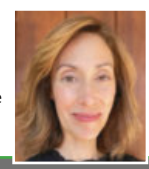
