## From the Desk of ... "He Ascended into Heaven..."

This Past Thursday we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord. Each time we Profess our Faith, we state this line. **"He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father."** It is fitting that the Risen Lord would be united with the Father by ascending to His throne in Heaven. They are one. The Trinity is perfectly united. Today's Gospel is taken from Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane on the Mount of Olives. Listen to our Lord's passionate plea for our unity to the Father and Son. He prays fervently not only for the Reunion with the Father and the Son, but also our union with and them. From today's Gospel: "so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may be brought to perfection as one".

This oneness is fulfilled in His Church. Jesus Christ is the Head, and we are the Body. When baptized, we were grafted to the Body, and we were incorporated into the Trinity. Through our Baptism, we are each called to continue building that church, in the tradition of the first disciples. God's gift of Redemption for sin, and eternal life are accomplished through Jesus Christ and continues in His Church. Gifts freely given, and the beauty of these gifts is that they are meant to be shared.

While Our Lord is already present in his Church, His reign is yet to be fulfilled by the King's return to earth. Yes, the Ascension marked the entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly realm. We also proclaim that He come again.

What about the "in-between" time between the Ascension and the Christ's return? That time is our time. We are living in the time of the Church. It is our time and our mission of bringing Heaven and Earth together. Next week is Pentecost and we celebrate the Birth of the Church.



## Saint of the Week

Burned at the stake as a heretic after a politically-motivated trial, Joan was beatified in 1909 and canonized in 1920. Born of a fairly well-to-do peasant couple in Domremy-Greux southeast of Paris, Joan was only 12 when she experienced a vision and heard voices that she later identified as Saints Michael the Archangel, Catherine of Alexandria, and Margaret of Antioch.

During the Hundred Years War, Joan led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. This enabled Charles VII to be crowned as king in Reims in 1429. Captured near Compiegne the following year, Joan was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft. In the end, she was condemned for wearing men's clothes. The English resented France's military success–to which Joan contributed.

On this day in 1431, Joan was burned at the stake in Rouen, and her ashes were scattered in the Seine River. A second Church trial 25 years later nullified the earlier verdict, which was reached under political pressure.

Remembered by most people for her military exploits, Joan had a great love for the sacraments, which strengthened her compassion toward the poor.
