

From the Desk of ... The Trinity...a model for our relationships

When you make the sign of the cross, you are expressing a faith in three persons. You have proclaimed that any action that follows is being done in the name of the three persons. Trinity, in Christian doctrine (Trinitarian doctrine), defines God as being one God existing in three consubstantial (of one and the same essence, nature) divine persons: God the Father, God the Son (Jesus Christ) and God the Holy Spirit. Trinity Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, (the 50th day after Easter), is a Solemnity having been instituted to honor the **Most Holy Trinity**.

In the Trinity, God exists as three persons but is one being, having a single divine nature. The members of the Trinity are co-equal and co-eternal, one in essence, nature and power. "The Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit" are not names for different parts of God, but one name for God because three persons exist in God as one entity. They cannot be separate from one another. Each person is understood as having the identical essence or nature. When you repeat the Nicene Creed (from the Latin *credo*, which means "I believe") at Mass, you are saying that you believe in a Father and Son and Holy Spirit. The Creed begins with the words: "We believe in one God". This belief was there from the earliest beginnings of the Church. St. Paul, in his Second Letter to the Corinthians: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you" (13:13). St. Paul's greeting recognizes three Persons in God.

It was not until later in the 4th century, that the individuality of the three and their unity, were brought together in a single doctrine of one essence and three persons. The First Council of Nicaea in 325, stated the crucial formula for the doctrine that the Son is "of the same substance as the Father," even though it said very little about the Holy Spirit. Over the next half century, St. Athanasius defended and refined the Nicene formula. By the end of the 4th century, the doctrine of the Trinity took in fact the trinitarian form it has maintained ever since.

The Persons of the Trinity know how to be in relationship. They have great, total, and eternal joy in one another. This love is so strong that it inspires and strengthens us.



Saint of the Week

June 15 is the feast day of St. Germaine **Cousin**, a simple and pious young girl who lived in Pibrac, France in the late 1500s. Germaine was born in 1579 to poor parents. She was born with a deformed right arm and hand, as well as the disease of scrofula, a tubercular condition. Her father remarried soon after the death of her mother, but his new wife was filled with disgust by Germaine's condition. She tormented and neglected Germaine. Despite her hardships, she lived each day full of thanksgiving and joy, and spent much of her time praying the Rosary and teaching the village children about the love of God. From her simple faith grew a deep holiness and profound trust in God. She went to Mass everyday, leaving her sheep in the care of her guardian angel, who never failed her. Her father found her body on her bed of leaves one morning in her 22nd year of life. Fortythree years later, when a relative of hers was being buried, Germaine's casket was opened and her body was found incorrupt. People in the surrounding area began praying for her intercession and obtaining miraculous cures for illnesses. St. Germaine was canonized by Pope Pius IX in 1867 and inscribed into the canon of virgins.
