From the Desk of ... Being Disciples

This Sunday's readings are about dealing with the challenges of living our calling as disciples of Christ. And answering this call to follow Jesus requires some determination. We may be asked to let go of things we are attached to, or leave behind family and familiar places, or do things we've never done. Naturally, this causes a reluctance in us due to our fear of the unknown. What will we do without those people, places, or things? Or what happens if we don't succeed?

Notice that same pattern of concern in the readings. Elisha is initially reluctant to follow Elijah. The people Jesus calls to follow him offer why they cannot immediately do so. And Saint Paul reminds us that our new life in the Spirit requires us to leave behind our old life in the flesh. All evidence that overcoming our natural tendencies is crucial to fully living our discipleship.

If we're experiencing a reluctance to grow more in our discipleship, to move out of our comfort zone and take the next step, we must ask ourselves what's really holding me back? What am I afraid to do—or stop doing—that prevents me from doing what God is asking? Likewise, we must then remind ourselves that we will not be alone in this effort. Jesus said he would always be with us and he gave us his Holy Spirit and Grace to do whatever he has asked us to do. We simply need to continue to trust God, master ourselves, and be Jesus as best we can. **Robert Cargill, Director of Faith Formation**



Saint of the Week

Oliver Plunkett, a 17th-century Irish martyr, became Ireland's first new saint in nearly 700 years after being canonized in 1975. In 1997, he was deemed the country's patron saint for peace and reconciliation. Saint Oliver Plunkett (1st November 1625 -1st July 1681) was the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of All Ireland. He maintained his duties in Ireland in the face of English persecution and was eventually arrested and tried for treason in London. He was hanged, drawn and quartered at Tyburn on 1 July 1681, and became the last Roman Catholic martyr to die in England. Plunket was beatified by Benedict XV in 1920 and canonized by Pope Paul VI on Oct. 12, 1975. His head is preserved at Drogheda and his body at Downside Abbey, near Bath.


