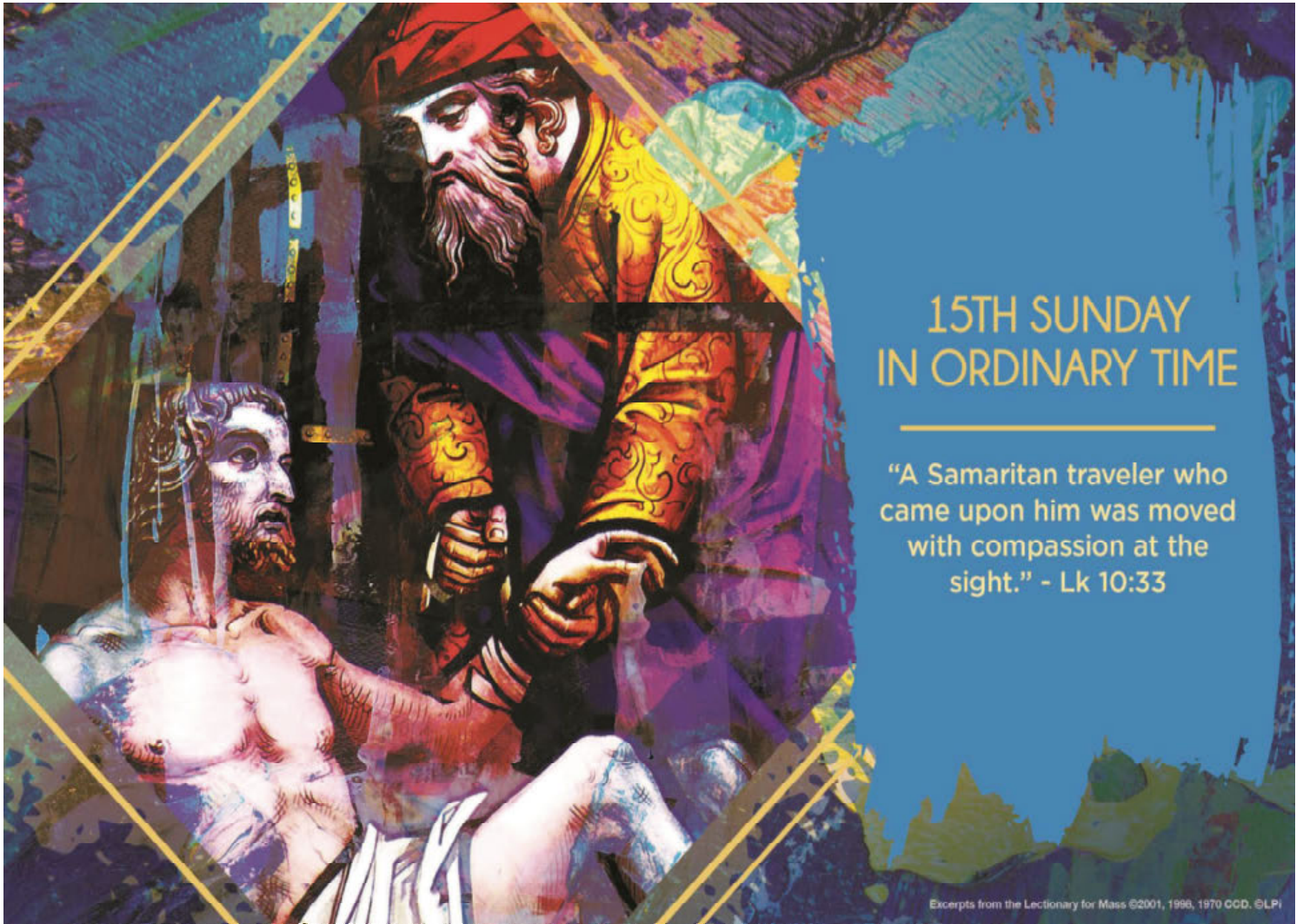

From the Desk of ...

I have been dwelling on a question posed in a song that first rocked the airwaves back in 2004. The song is titled “**Heaven**”, and it came to us from the band “Los Lonely Boys”. The song repeatedly asks, “**How far is Heaven?**”. Good question! So good, in fact, that we should all take the time to ponder it.

The song popped into my head as I reflected on the first reading from today’s mass. In the first reading, Moses declares that the Lord’s commands are not found in some faraway place “*too mysterious and remote for you*” Moses then adds “*No, it is something very near to you, already in your mouths and in your hearts; you have only to carry it out.*”

This is the law that Moses says is written on our lips and in our hearts. “You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.”

The Gospel today echoes this command. It is the answer to the opening question. “*There was a scholar of the law who stood up to test Jesus and said, “Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?” In other words, “**How do I get to Heaven?**” Jesus responds with the Parable of the Good Samaritan, and concludes with a question to the scholar: “Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbor to the robbers’ victim?” He answered, “The one who treated him with mercy.” Jesus said to him, “Go and do likewise.”*”

How far is Heaven? It might be closer to us than we are to ourselves. Heaven is as close as our works of love and mercy. It is as close as our prayer and worship can allow. Please keep in mind that we are privileged to be joined with Heaven during the Mass.

So, as we ponder the question, we may need a little self-examination to contemplate the answer. Better yet... “*you have only to carry it out.*” “**Go and do likewise**”

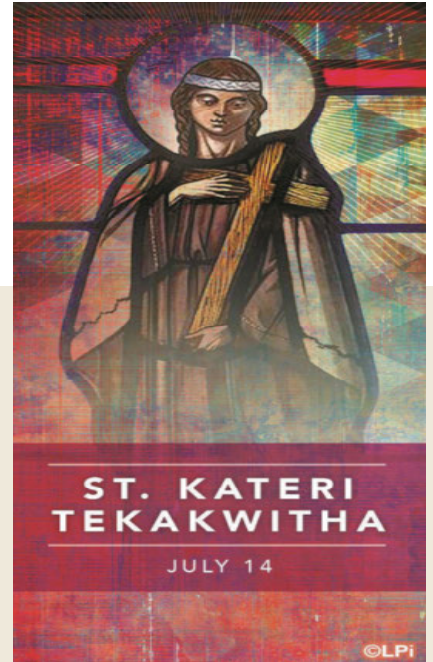
