

# **Pastor's Note ...** SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME


In today's Gospel, we hear St. Luke's version of the Lord's Prayer. St. Luke's version is shorter and uses different language than the one we commonly pray from St. Matthew's Gospel. The difference in its language and length demonstrate that prayer is not an exercise in getting the exact words to make a perfect prayer. A parent doesn't require an infant to always ask for what they need in correct grammar and words. To quote Jesus from today's Gospel, "...how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him."

Along with presenting the Our Father, Jesus encourages us to persevere in prayer. He encourages us to persevere shamelessly and boldly. Jesus wants us to ask, seek and knock. Jesus reminds us that God's desire is to do good for us even when we feel as if we are pestering God, or when God seems to not be listening to our urgent requests. The good news Jesus reveals to us is that we are able to feel secure and not doubt God's love, even when life mounts hardships against us. We must ask, seek and knock, knowing that a loving God is ready to respond in some way.
