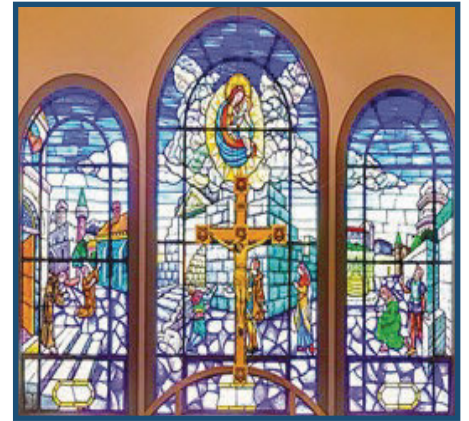

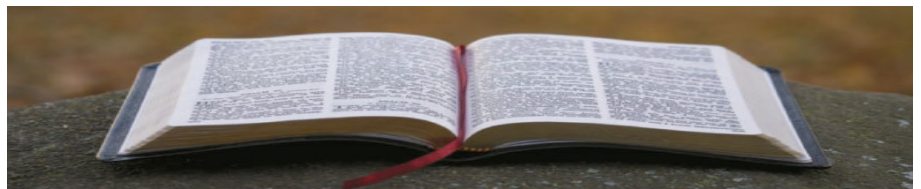

Pastor's Note ... EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's First Reading from Ecclesiastes introduces us to the skeptic of the Old Testament. The teacher who speaks in this book is a man who comes across as having seen it all and tried it all. He is an individual whose instruction might leave us wondering, "So now what?" The opening line in the First Reading, "Vanity of vanities" (1:2), is intended to make us take a look at our priorities in life. The Hebrew word *vanity* can be translated as vapor, breath meaningless and even transitoriness.

Today's Gospel paraphrases Ecclesiastes 8:15 ("Therefore I praised joy, because there is nothing better for mortals under the sun than to eat and to drink and to be joyful.") when the landowner says to himself, "...you have so many good things stored up for many years, rest, eat, drink, be merry!" (Luke 12:19). With this parable, Jesus is teaching us how ridiculous it is to hoard what we have received. Jesus is challenging us to take a look at our priorities.

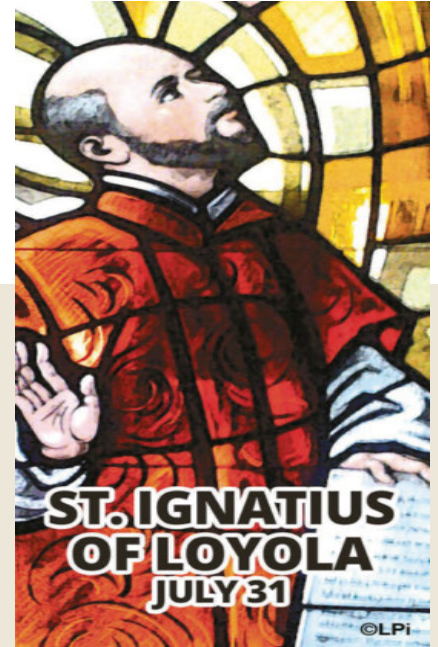

Important — Daily Mass Update OLS & OLCG

There will be Daily Mass on Saturday, July 30 at 9:00 a.m., but that will be the last daily Mass until Tuesday, August 9. The regular daily mass schedule will resume on August 9th at OLS and OLCG.

On the weekend of August 13-14, 2022 our parish will host a speaker for the Alliance for International Monasticism (AIM USA). Once a year, as part of the Missionary Cooperative Plan throughout the United States, each parish in the diocese welcomes a member or an associate of a religious community involved in missionary work. Sister Donald Corcoran, OSB Cam from Transfiguration Monastery in Windsor, NY, is this year's representative who will share with you some of the work of AIM USA. AIM USA has formed an alliance between 140 US and Canadian monasteries with over 400 Benedictine and Cistercian monasteries in Africa, Asia, the Caribbean and Latin America and Eastern Europe. These Benedictine and Cistercian women and men form centers of prayer, education, health and agriculture in some of the poorest regions of the world.
