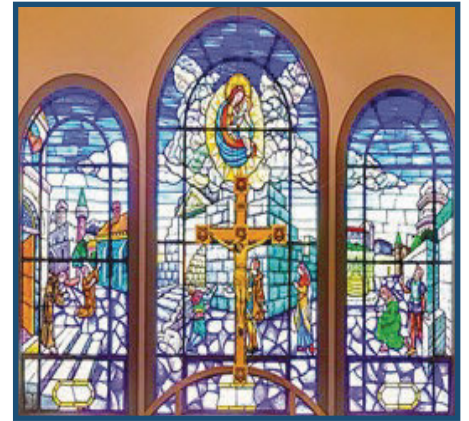

Pastor's Note ... Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more." The last verse of today's Gospel ought to make us sit up and take notice. Not all of us have been entrusted with great wealth or significant power, but we have all received a priceless gift. It's the gift of faith. With this gift of faith comes a huge responsibility. The responsibility we have is to share that gift with others.

Over the last few years I have led a mission trip to Haiti in conjunction with an organization called Haiti180 (Haiti180 has a website if you would like more information). One of the memorable experiences I had was witnessing the faith of the Haitian people. I have had the opportunity to travel around the world, but never have I seen the depth of poverty I saw as when I was in Haiti. Yet, in the midst of this extreme poverty, I encountered people who had nothing but the gift of faith God gave them, and that gift filled their souls with an overflowing abundance of love and joy. Although materially poor, spiritually, the peoples' sense of gratitude for the gift of faith sprung forth from their hearts like a torrent from a raging stream.
