



# Good News

Praise Jesus!

This weekend is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Sunday Lectionary readings that we have been hearing from the Bread of Life Discourse (John 6) take a pause this week as we hear the readings from Revelation, 1 Corinthians and the Gospel of Luke. I would like to offer some pointers for this feast in preparation for the Adoration Series that will be offered in the bulletin article over the next three weeks.

In 1950, Pope Pius XII proclaimed the Dogma of the Assumption of Mary in the Apostolic Constitution, *Munificentissimus Deus*, in which he describes how God willed that the Blessed Virgin Mary should be exempted from the corruption of death through the unique privilege of her Immaculate Conception, and as a result, she was not subject to the law of remaining in the corruption of the grave. Thus, she did not have to wait until the end of time for the redemption of her body.

She is truly assumed body and soul into the beatific vision of heaven, which is a prototype for the Church. It demonstrates to us what we shall eventually attain. This is why she is rightly referred to (in the *Salve Regina* prayer, see below) as our life, our sweetness and our hope. What God has done for her is a foreshadowing of what He shall do for us - all his saints. The Catechism states it this way, "The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christian." (CCC 966).

Our Lady first conceived the Word in her heart before conceiving in her womb, and because she is so intimately joined to her Son, she fully shares in His Glory.

In the Old Testament we see the Ark of the Covenant in the Holy of Holies. This was because the Ark contained the manna, the high priest's staff and the commandments of the Law. Since the New fulfills the Old, we see Mary as the New Ark of the Covenant, precisely because in her was contained Jesus, Who is the Bread of life (true Manna), the Great High Priest and the fulfillment of the Law. The fascinating thing about this is that as the Ark was in the Holy of Holies in its physical state, so too, is the New Ark in the Holy of Holies (heaven) in her physical state.

St. Peter Julian Eymard, whose feast day we just celebrated August 2nd, firmly believed that the closer someone is to Mary, the closer they are to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Since Jesus is truly, really and substantially present in the Most Holy Eucharist, then it stands to reason that there is a connection between Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Blessed Mother. Mary was the first tabernacle and monstrance so to speak, and when in her womb, Mary performed the first Eucharistic Procession during the Visitation to her cousin Elizabeth

Eymard continues his prose by stating, "O how well was Our Lord served in Mary's womb! Never has He found a ciborium, a vase of gold more precious, or purer than Mary, for as the psalmist proclaims, the Lord hath placed His tabernacle in the sun." "At Bethlehem, Mary was the first to adore her Divine Son lying in the crib. She adored Him with the perfect love of a Virgin Mother." (Month of Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament).

In the Gospel of John, we see Mary being not only a witness to one of the Eucharistic miracles when Jesus transformed water into wine at the Wedding at Cana, but also the intercessory catalyst for this. A very crucial dimension of the bond between mother and son, established at the Annunciation, was made manifest at Cana. In those moments of the Gospel where Jesus and Mary are together, her actions, worship, words and posture establish criteria for adoration of the Lord.

So let us ponder not only the unbreakable bond of Mother and Son on this glorious Feast of the Assumption, but the divinely established relation of the Eucharistic and Mary. For as our late Holy Father St. Pope John Paul II adequately stated, "If the Church and the Eucharist are inseparably united, the same ought to be said of Mary and the Eucharist." (Blessed Pope John Paul II, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia*)

Adoration of our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament is one of the most prayers and deepest source of spirituality. I hope and pray that the bulletin articles over the next few weeks will draw us more deeply into this spiritual practice.

## REFLECTION ON THE ASSUMPTION OF OUR LADY & ORDINATION BY BRIAN MIZZONI
