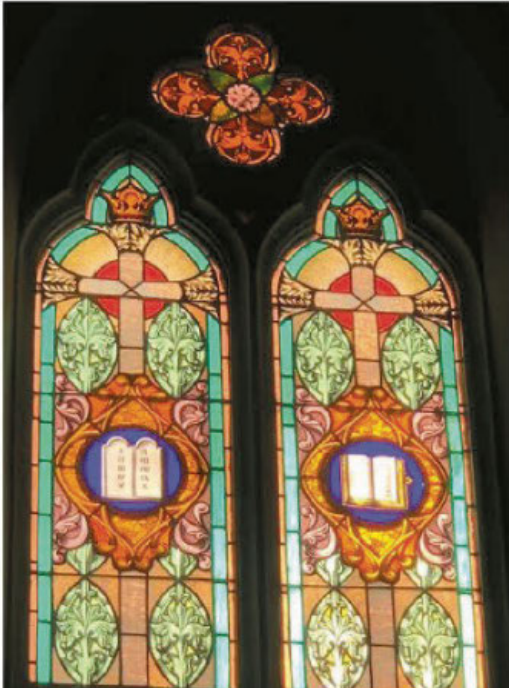

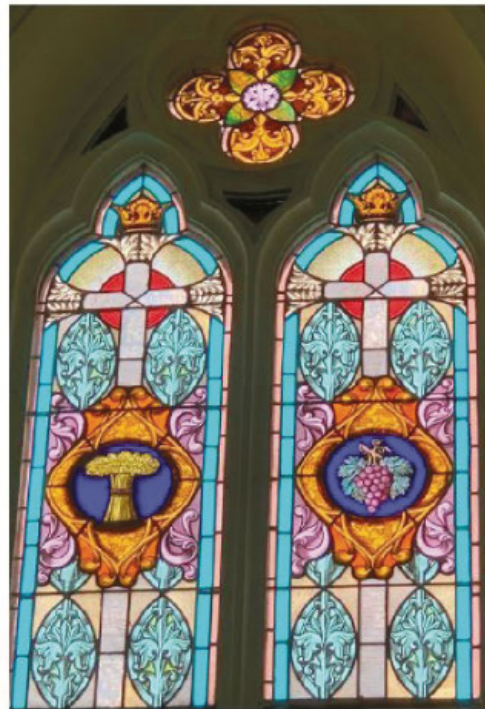

Pope Francis is inviting everyone to have “a more humble Christmas” this year.

At the end of his weekly general audience December 14th, the pope asked people to consider spending less on gifts and parties and in order to help the people of Ukraine. “It is good to celebrate Christmas, to have parties — but let’s lower the level of Christmas spending,” he encouraged. “Let’s send what we save to the Ukrainian people, who are in need, suffering so much; they go hungry, they feel the cold, and so many die because there are no doctors, nurses at hand.” “Let’s have a more humble Christmas, with more humble gifts,” he said. “Be at peace with the Lord, he said, and “let us make that concrete gesture” for the people of Ukraine.”

In sharing this with others, we were wondering about exactly where to donate to be sure it gets to the people it is supposed to get to in Ukraine. St. Nicholas Ukrainian Catholic Church in Elmira Heights and the priest there, Fr. Moreno, wanted us to pass along this, helpful information on how to donate for Ukraine. The need is going to be there for a long time.

Fr. Moreno said the Ukrainian Church has transports that go to the Ukraine and deliver donations, and have one (or had one already go) for Christmas. He said Sacred Heart Ukrainian Catholic Church in Johnson City, NY is the hub for donations, but anything sent at any time to St. Nicholas' Church with the notation "Ukraine Fund" will get there. Their website is www.SacredHeartUCC.org under the tab "Assistance for Ukraine" to see all the information about what is needed, plus have access to an Amazon wish list.

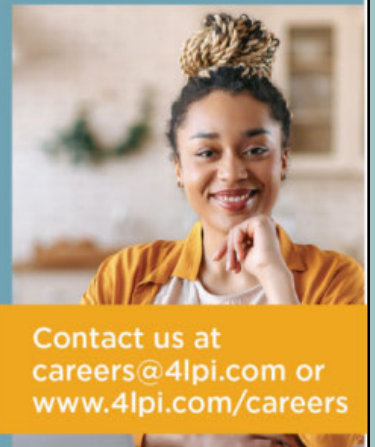



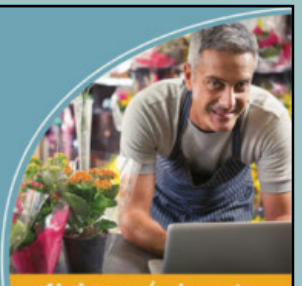
