GOOD NEWS

From the Passover to the Last Supper.

In the celebration of the Passover, they were reminded to celebrate it every year in remembrance of their deliverance out of Egypt into the promised land.

In the context of coming together in preparation for the Passover celebration. Jesus had a meal with his disciples and in that meal, he called it the Last supper.

“On the first day of the feast of unleavened bread, the disciples approached Jesus and said, “where do you want us to prepare for you to eat the Passover?” He said, Go into the city to a certain man and tell him. The teacher says, “my appointed time draws near: in your house I shall celebrate the Passover with my disciples.” “The disciples then did as Jesus had ordered and prepared the Passover. *MT. 26:21-19.*

While they were eating Jesus took bread, said the blessing, broke it and giving it to his disciples said take and eat, this is my body. Then he took the cup gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying drink from it all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant which will be shed for the forgiveness of sins. I tell you from now on I will not drink this fruit of the vine, until the day when I will drink it with you new in the Kingdom of my Father.” *Mt. 26:26-29.*

In the first letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians. He orders like they were ordered while celebrating the Passover that they were to do it in remembrance of their release from captivity in Egypt he also ordered them to do it in remembrance of Him. He died without sin to save us from the bondage of sin.

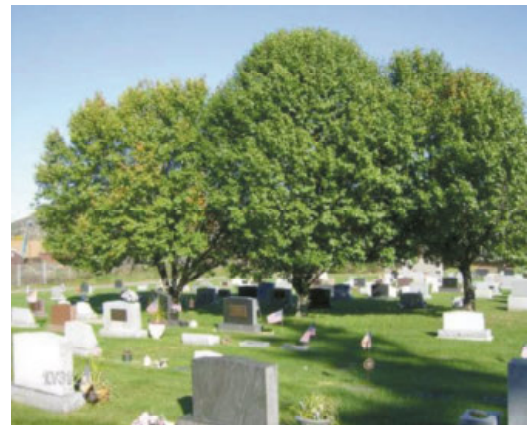

During Lent our community will participate in **CRS Rice Bowl**, a faith-in-action program that invites us to encounter the needs of the world with the hope of the Resurrection. Bowls will be at the back of the Church through Lent.



All Saints Parish, Corning, NY is seeking a full-time (35 hours per week) non-exempt Coordinator or Faith Formation. This position requires working frequent evenings and weekends.

The Coordinator of Faith Formation will be responsible for:

- Overseeing all Parish religious education programs, Children’s Liturgy of the Word, and Sacramental preparation for Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation.
- Recruit, train, and support all volunteers involved in programs.
- Supervise a part-time Office Assistant who gives support to both the Faith Formation office and Parish office, and all volunteers involved in any of our Formation activities.
- Oversees the Creating A Safe Environment (CASE) training, documentation, and reporting procedures for the Parish. This is accomplished by working directly with the Office Assistant and Ministry Leaders to assure all volunteers are following CASE directives.
- Maintain office records such as attendance, expenses, Catechists training, and Sacramental records.
- Expected to attend staff meetings in the Parish and regionally, as well as Diocesan meetings and activities offered by the Dept. Of Evangelization and Catechists, throughout the year.

Qualifications:

- Applicant should (minimally) be certified as a Catechetical Coordinator or be willing to become certified.
- They should have strong technological and organizational skills.
- They should be able to lead and motivate children and work collaboratively with parents and other staff members.

Training and Development:

- Professional Development training is available and provided by the Diocesan Office of Evangelization and Catechesis, both online and in-person.

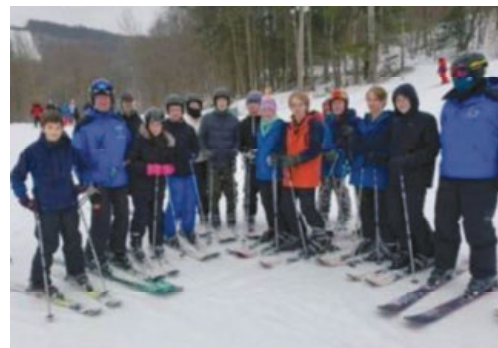
Ski Trip to Greek Peak

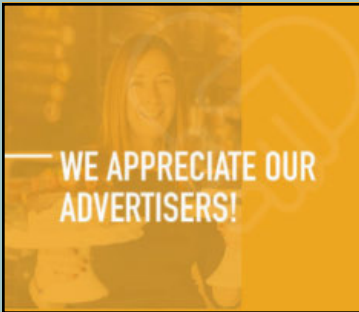
