Behold the Wood of the Cross - Come let us Adore

It's hard to believe Holy Week is upon us and there will be many opportunities to prepare to enter into the mystery of our Lord's passion and death during this sacred time. One such efficacious way is through Eucharistic Adoration. The Catechism beautifully tells us that since Christ was about to take His departure, He wanted to give us His Sacramental Presence and since He was about to offer Himself on the cross to save us, He wanted us to have the memorial of the love with which He loved us to the end, even to the giving of his life (CCC 1380.)

With all the wonderful programs offered during this upcoming sacred week, there will be Eucharistic Adoration every day beginning on Palm Sunday through Holy Wednesday. Each day, (Sun, Mon, Wed), with the exception of Tuesday which will be the usual Adoration from 9am-9pm, our Lord will be exposed from 1:00pm to 7:00pm and I personally encourage everyone to please come, even if only for a few moments, to Adore Jesus, for it is most fitting to keep watch with Him - (Matt 26:40.)

Again, the Catechism explains that Adoration is the first attitude of man acknowledging that he is a creature before his Creator. It exalts the greatness of the Lord who made us and the almighty power of the Savior who sets us free from evil. Adoration is homage of the spirit to the "King of Glory," **respectful silence in the presence of the "ever greater" God.** Adoration of the thrice-holy and sovereign God of love blends with humility and gives assurance to our supplications. (CCC 2628.)

On Good Friday we will fully enter His passion and chant that most sober of lines "behold, behold, the wood of the cross on which is hung our salvation." So, my friends, let us indeed come and adore!

The All Saints Parish Evening Rosary Group Invites You This Lent to Pray with Us!

The Evening Rosary Group was begun on May 1, 2020 by the Anawim Community in response to Pope Francis' call to pray the Rosary daily through May for an end to the pandemic. At the end of May, those who had done this via Zoom decided to continue praying together until Fall...then to the end of the year...then into 2021...and for almost three years now, about 15-20+ people have met every evening on Zoom to say the Rosary together. Needless to say, we now have a "Rosary Family" who would love to welcome even more people to pray with us this Lent.

In today's tumultuous world, devotion to the Rosary and faith in its transformative power are desperately needed more than ever. Pope Pius XI during his pontificate in 1922-39, said these words which still ring so true: *"The Rosary is a powerful weapon to put demons to flight and to keep oneself from sin...If you desire peace in your hearts, in your homes, and in your country, assemble each evening to recite the Rosary. Let not even one day pass without saying it, no matter how burdened you may be with the many cares and labors."*

Our Rosary group has done exactly that. Won't you come join us? It's simple! Just contact our leader, Teresa Graham, at tmgraham@stny.rr.com and she will send you the Zoom email link. At 7:25 PM, on any evening, click on the link and it will take you to our Rosary group. Recitation starts at 7:30 PM (but no problem at all if you come in late), led by a different set of partners each night of the week. Everyone else mutes and prays to themselves. We are done by 8:00. There is no obligation to come every night; just come whenever you want. That said, the 20 or so of us who are on regularly have found that setting this time aside every night to pray together is an uplifting and powerful grace in our prayer life. After almost 1,095 rosary nights, we all still look forward to it! We hope to share this very special ministry with more parishioners this Lent. Praying the Rosary together will anchor our Lenten practices, deepen our walk with Jesus, and strengthen our Parish.

As we approach Easter, the Knights of Columbus encourages families in the parish community to attend Good Friday liturgies on April 7th. - Supervise a part-time Office Assistant who gives support to both the Faith Formation office and Parish office, and all volunteers involved in any of our Formation activities.
- Oversees the Creating A Safe Environment (CASE) training, documentation, and reporting procedures for the Parish. This is accomplished by working directly with the Office Assistant and Ministry Leaders to assure all volunteers are following CASE directives.
- Maintain office records such as attendance, expenses, Catechists training, and Sacramental records.
- Expected to attend staff meetings in the Parish and regionally, as well as Diocesan meetings and activities offered by the Dept. Of Evangelization and Catechists, throughout the year.

Qualifications:

- Applicant should (minimally) be certified as a Catechetical Coordinator or be willing to become certified.
- They should have strong technological and organizational skills.
- They should be able to lead and motivate children and work collaboratively with parents and other staff members.

Training and Development:

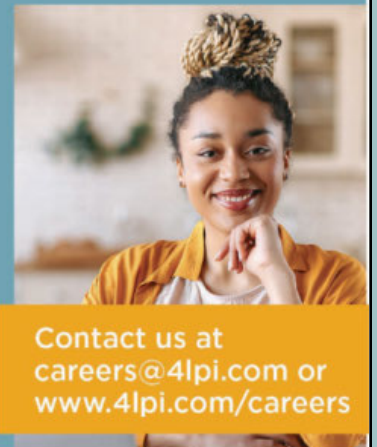


