PASTOR'S COLUMN - NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends in Christ,

In the Second Reading for this weekend's masses, we hear from one of my favorite books of the Bible, the Letter to the Hebrews. It is a letter that is making clear the fact that Jesus is divine and also the High Priest of the New Covenant. It is through the sacrifice that this High Priest offers that hope is given and eternal life secured for all who come to believe in Him. We read that ***Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen.***

The letter is inviting us to have the vision of faith through which we recognize that we **have approached Mount Zion and the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and countless angels in festal gathering, and the assembly of the firstborn enrolled in heaven, and God the judge of all, and the spirits of the just made perfect, and Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and the sprinkled blood that speaks more eloquently than that of Abel.** (Hebrews 12:22-24)

*The gift of faith helps us see what goes unseen to those who have no or little faith. It is especially in the mass that this is most true. Through the gift and vision of faith we grow in our appreciation of how the liturgy of the Eucharist is a participation in the heavenly liturgy. The previous quote makes this clear. When have we **approached Mount Zion, and the assembly in heaven**, (in Greek, the word assembly is the same word for Church) and **Jesus the mediator of a new covenant?***

It is when we participate in the celebration of the mass. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains:

"In the earthly liturgy we share in a foretaste of that heavenly liturgy which is celebrated in the Holy City of

Jerusalem toward which we journey as pilgrims, where Christ is sitting at the right hand of God, Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle. With all the warriors of the heavenly army we sing a hymn of glory to the Lord; venerating the memory of the saints,

we hope for some part and fellowship with them; we eagerly await the Savior, our Lord Jesus Christ, until he, our life, shall appear and we too will appear with him in glory." (CCCC, #1090)

There are four commonly used *Eucharistic Prayers* (The prayers used at the time of the consecration) that can be used during the celebration of the mass. All of them invite us to grow in this mystical awareness. Paying attention to the Eucharistic Prayer offers us, at every mass, an opportunity to grow in the vision of faith through which we perceive our participation in the heavenly liturgy.

*In the Second Eucharistic Prayer, which is the used at nearly every daily, we can hear the following proclamation: Therefore, as we celebrate the memorial of his Death and Resurrection, we offer you, Lord, the Bread of life and the Chalice of salvation, giving thanks that **you have held us worthy to be in your presence** and minister to you.*

It is my prayer that we all grow, at every mass, in our appreciation of the great mystery of love that is made manifest for our peace and ultimate salvation.

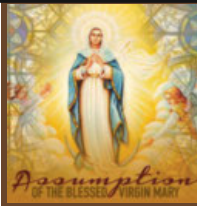


UNBOUND COMING TO SAINT DANIEL
