## PASTOR'S COLUMN - TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends in Christ,

In the Gospel this weekend we have an invitation to contemplate what is called the *Universal Call to Holiness*. An expression of this same proclamation is found in St. Paul's First letter to Timothy:

***First of all, then, I ask that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for everyone, for kings and for all in authority, that we may lead a quiet and tranquil life in all devotion and dignity. This is good and pleasing to God our savior, who wills everyone to be saved and to come to knowledge of the truth. For there is one God. There is also one mediator between God and the human race, Christ Jesus, himself human, who gave himself as ransom for all.*** (1 Timothy 2:1-6)

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that ***"...people will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and will recline at table in the kingdom of God. For behold, some are last who will be first, and some are first who will be last."***

All Christians are called to the holiness of life, and to invite others to know and receive this same gift and calling. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains: "All Christians in any state or walk of life are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of charity." All are called to holiness: "Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect." In order to reach this perfection the faithful should use the strength dealt out to them by Christ's gift, so that . . . doing the will of the Father in everything, they may wholeheartedly devote themselves to the glory of God and to the service of their neighbor. Thus the holiness of the People of God will grow in fruitful abundance,

as is clearly shown in the history of the Church through the lives of so many saints.

***Spiritual progress tends toward ever more intimate union with Christ.*** ... The way of perfection passes by way of the Cross. There is no holiness without renunciation and spiritual battle. Spiritual progress entails the asceticism and mortification that gradually lead to living in the peace and joy of the Beatitudes: He who climbs never stops going from beginning to beginning, through beginnings that have no end. He never stops desiring what he already knows. (CCC, 2013 -2015)

The Second Reading also invites us to recognize that *Spiritual progress tends toward ever more intimate union with Christ*: "My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reproved by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines. Endure your trials as "discipline"; God treats you as sons. For what "son" is there whom his father does not discipline? All discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it.

Conversion is not a *One and Done* moment in the life of a true disciple of Christ. True discipleship requires constant growth and ever increased union with Christ who thus exhorts us: "If anyone wishes to come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will save it." (Luke 9:23-24)
