

**A Note from Father Zach:**

God doesn't see as humans see. This is a very true fact about God. The world isn't how we think it ought to be, and we often find ourselves trying to change the world rather than just living in it. In the first reading today, we see God choosing David for something greater, and who is this future king? He is the youngest and smallest son of Samuel. As David was out tending the sheep, God saw something in him that the world did not see; something special that, with the proper training and patience, he had the ability to become something great. Even when Jesus first chose His disciples and the Apostles, they were not ready for the challenge. Still, Jesus saw something greater and, through time and teaching, showed them how God sees the world.

Ask yourselves these questions: How do we see the world with God? Has God called us to something special? How do we live out our life with God?



We have completed the 2022 Hope Appeal. Both Christ the King and Pope John XXIII have reached their goals. At this time, Christ the King has raised \$35,475, which is 100% of their goal. Pope John XXIII has raised \$51,502, which is 103% of their goal of \$50,260, and the parish will receive in return \$1,241 (Any parish that exceeds their goal will receive 100% of the overage). Together we have raised \$85,735 towards the ministries that the Diocese of Syracuse provides throughout the seven counties of the diocese. Thank you to all who have prayerfully given to the Hope Appeal and help make the ministries of the parishes and diocese possible.

I would like to personally invite everyone in the parish, along with your family and friends, to attend the IHC Mystery Players' The Way of the Cross, which will be held on Friday, March 24th, at 7:30pm in the church at Pope John XXIII. This is a wonderful opportunity to live out the Stations of the Cross and the powerful message of the Via Dolorosa: the way of the cross and how Jesus saves the world.

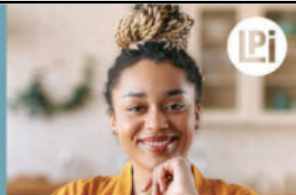

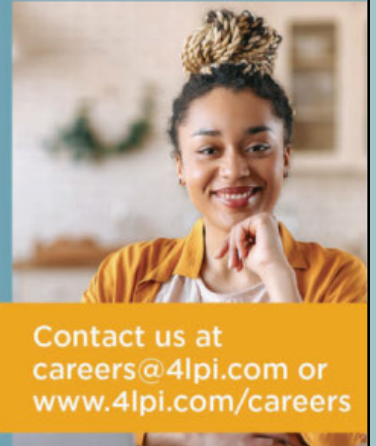
