A Note from Father Zach:

Holy Week brings the Gospel to life. Next weekend is Palm Sunday, the Beginning of Holy Week, the week that changes the world. Each year as we conclude our Lenten journey with Holy Week, it is a special time when we understand more deeply the great love that God has for us. This past week we celebrated the Living Stations of the Cross with the high school students from Immaculate Conception School in Watertown. This event had me recalling the great experience of leading a pilgrimage to see the Passion Play at Oberammergau this past summer. It was this play that helped me to realize the importance of Holy Week and all the events of Jesus' life. This is one of the most important messages in the world that through Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, God's love is shown to us. The Passion Play at Oberammergau ends with the Resurrection. This version of the Resurrection is not what most



Americans would think of. It's a very quiet and personal moment; the moment is about one's interaction with Jesus and how He has touched the new faith of the Disciples. The last words spoken in the Play are from Mary of Magdala: "Jesus brings the light, the fire into the world as a sign of hope." This week, we prepare for Holy Week and Palm Sunday and seek out the fire in the silence of the night.

Please join us for all the events of Holy Week.
