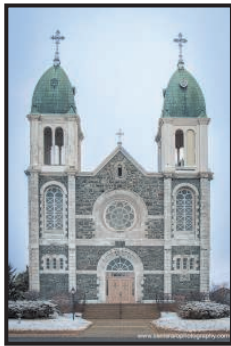

"DIVISION"

Last weekend in the gospel reading Jesus spoke to us about being servants who do the will of the master. He spoke about knowing the master's will and doing it otherwise we would suffer greatly. That to those to whom much has been given much more will be expected of them and if we fail to do the master's will our punishment will be greater. This week Jesus continues by teaching us that he has come not to establish peace on earth but rather division! This sounds very unlike the Jesus we have come to know and love.

Once again what does it mean to be the prudent servant? The prudent servant does the will of the master. We are called as God's sons and daughters, to do the will of our heavenly Father. But what is the Father's will? Jesus says he wants to set the world on fire. What does that mean? Why is Jesus talking about doing the Father's will, being prudent stewards and warning us that punishment is in store for those who choose not to do the Father's will. It would seem that these words of encouragement and warning are given because the leaders of His day were not prudent stewards. They were not doing the will of the Father. They were headed for very severe punishment and Jesus' message is God's mercy given to the Pharisees as words of warning.

The first reading from Jeremiah tells how God's warnings given to the people of Judah are not heeded by Zedekiah the weak king, his nobles nor the people of Jerusalem, which is under seizure by the Babylonians. However, Ebedmelech, a Cushite, a foreigner, intercedes on Jeremiah's behalf so that God's prophet may continue to bring the message of repentance to the leader of Judea. Zedekiah, the king, will not listen to Jeremiah. He will not heed God's warning and soon Judah will fall and the Jews, like the Israelites before them, will be exiled to Babylon for 490 years.

Are we listening today to the message of Jesus? This very day are we doing the will of our Father in heaven? The followers of Jesus are certainly divided, but is there a flame that has ignited the earth? What is the focus of our passion? Jesus came to proclaim the Father's desire to give us the kingdom. Do we proclaim that same message in the way we treat the marginalized of our society? Do we welcome the stranger? Do we feed the hungry and clothe the naked? Do we love those who are different from us? Are we prudent stewards or are we headed for a severe beating? It is prudent to examine what we are doing today.
