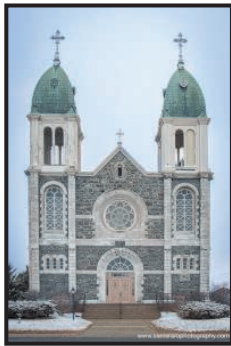

“DISHONEST WEALTH”

In the gospel reading today (Luke 16:1-13) Jesus speaks to us about the use of “dishonest wealth”. After telling the parable of the steward who squanders his master’s wealth Jesus says: “For the children of this world are more prudent in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. I tell you, make friends for yourselves with dishonest wealth, so that when it fails, you will be welcomed into eternal dwellings.” What does all this have to do with following Jesus and entering into eternal life?

The steward in the parable uses the master’s property to ensure that when he is released from his master’s employment he will be welcomed in to the home of the debtors who’s promissory note’s were reduced. The old, “I wash your hands, you will wash mine” theory. Notice the steward is referred to as dishonest, only after he has reduced the promissory notes, stealing from his master. The master’s money is really “dishonest wealth” not because of how it was derived, but because it is of little value in the scheme of eternity. Earthly wealth is passing away, It is of no value to us when we stand before the judgment seat of God. The steward uses the wealth to help secure a temporary earthly home for a short period of time, but he loses his soul in the process. He has become “dishonest”.

Jesus encourages us as children of light, to use this “dishonest wealth” wisely in this world that we may secure an “eternal dwelling”. How do we do this? By recognizing the wealth of this world for what it truly is; a means to do good for others. Yes, we must use our material wealth to provide food, shelter, and clothing for our families. We need to pay for our children’s education, provide for medical treatments and even have a little entertainment and fun for “All work and no play makes Johnnie a dull boy.” But what are the ways in which we can do good for others and use what God has blessed us with to give glory to his name and invite others to see God’s goodness in their lives?

We are currently conducting the 2019 Bishop’s Fund Appeal across our diocese. We are given the opportunity to join with others to make friends with our “dishonest wealth” so that we may have an “eternal dwelling”. Our Sunday offerings help to give glory to God as they maintain the Church’s active presence in the community. Our participation in Church activities bear witness to the goodness of God in our lives especially when we speak of God’s goodness as the reason for our generosity.

So what do you do with your “dishonest wealth”?

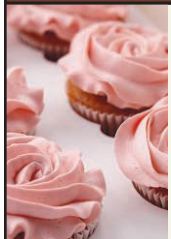
