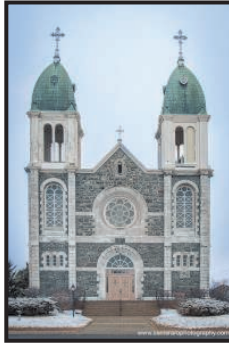

"SO HE MAY WARN THEM"

Continuing his teaching concerning the way of discipleship and the use of earthly goods, Jesus tells us the parable of the rich man who is complacent, dining sumptuously each day and wearing fine linen and purple garments. The rich man enjoys a life of material luxury while Lazarus lies at the rich man's door hungry and ill, longing to eat the scraps that fall from the rich man's table. When he dies Lazarus is taken to the bosom of Abraham where he is comforted in eternal life. The rich man is buried and suffers torment. The rich man in his suffering learns compassion for his five brothers asking that Lazarus be sent to warn them of the final judgment and to encourage them to repent of their evil ways, to stop squandering the master's possessions and become good stewards. Abraham tells the rich man that his brothers have the warnings from Moses and the prophets and if they will not listen to them, neither will they be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead.

History is a wonderful teacher if we listen to it and learn from its important lessons. The prophet Amos speaks God's words of warning given to the complacent in Zion His chosen people, who do not listen to God words and follow His commands. The kingdom of Judah did not learn from the mistakes of the northern kingdom of Israel which was destroyed and exiled for their wickedness. For some reason Judah could not see that they had taken up the same abominable actions their kinsmen had done in the north. They would suffer the same fate, destruction of their kingdom and exile to a foreign land.

St. Paul reminds Timothy and all of us that we are called to be men of God, to pursue righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience and gentleness. Doing so, we will lay hold of eternal life. St. Paul calls us to remember our confession of faith when we proclaimed the risen Lord Jesus, Lord of our life. Individually and corporately.

Are we complacent now? As individuals and a nation (both the Church and the USA)? Once again Jesus does not condemn the rich man for being rich. Nor does he condemn him for eating well or having a roof over his head. He is held accountable for squandering the blessings he has received without compassion for Lazarus who is hungry and ill at the door. The rich man eats sumptuously while Lazarus lies hungry. The rich man has material wealth but he is not poor in spirit. He has been entrusted with material wealth but has failed to be a good steward. Are we good stewards? Do we use the gifts we receive as God desires?

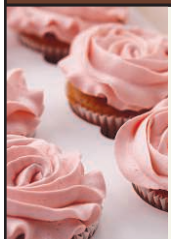
