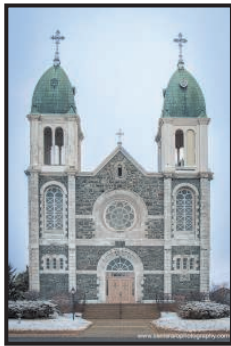

**"HE WAS CLEAN OF HIS LEPROSY"**

Naaman was a foreigner. He was not a Jew nor an Israelite. He did not know the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Matter of fact he was a general in the Syrian army which had conquered Israel and taken many of God's people into exile including a young girl who was a slave in Naaman's household. Yet this young girl remembered the commands of God. She prayed for her master and desired what was best for him. When Naaman contracted leprosy, a deadly disease, she told her master about the God of Israel. God who had great power, even if He did not use that power to defeat Naaman's army. She pleaded with her master to present himself to God's prophet in Israel. The faith of this young follower of God must have been very great. God heard and answered her prayer. Her master did present himself to Elisha who spoke God's words to him and Naaman washed in the Jordan River, seven times at God's command and was cleansed of his leprosy. Naaman, a foreigner and enemy of God's people, received new life because of a young slave girl's great faith in God. Imagine Naaman's gratitude to her when he returned home cured of this deadly disease.

The ten lepers, who are considered outcast by the pharisees because of their leprosy and because they were from Samaria and Galilee, call upon Jesus as Master to have pity on them. Their actions reveal a level of faith that Jesus can perform a cure on their behalf. Jesus sends them to the priest in accord with the law of God that the priests may pronounce them cleansed. It is the Samaritan foreigner who returns to Jesus glorifying God, worshiping Jesus and thanking him. Again a foreigner acts with greater faith and gratitude than the Jews who claimed to know God.

St. Paul encourages Timothy and us to have faith in Jesus Christ risen from the dead even when we have to suffer for our faith. Paul uses his own example of patient endurance to encourage us. He is in chains and tells us that the **"Word of God is not chained."**

To have faith great enough to effect change in the world we must really get to know the **Word of God**. Not just memorize words printed in the Bible. We need to come to know **Jesus, The Word of God**. Spoken to free us from sin and death. Spoken to free us from fear and depression. Spoken to give us life and hope in the midst of a crazy world. Jesus is real! Jesus is alive! Jesus is present in the world today! Jesus is active in your life and in mine! Lord help me to believe that I may be your unworthy servant.
