#### "BAPTISM"

Why is the Sacrament of Baptism serious business? It is serious business because through the Sacrament of Baptism we become a son or daughter of God through adoption in Jesus Christ. This is a wonderful gift that God bestows upon the individual and upon the community of believers. A gift from God! Reflect upon that for a moment. Not a gift from Santa Claus or your parents or a friend. This is a gift from the all powerful God. God who holds all creation in the palm of His hand. God bestows a gift upon me! He know me! He loves me! That is amazing! And this gift is not some toy that will be broken in a few days. Baptism is a gift for all eternity. It will never expire. It will not go out of style, rot away or die.

What makes Baptism such a wonderful gift? Baptism is given with love and at a great cost. We have just celebrated Christmas, the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ. We celebrated more than just the birth of Jesus of Nazareth. The Nativity of our Lord celebrates God's great love for us that He freely chose to become one of us in all things but sin. Jesus surrendered His Godliness and took on the human nature. A nature that was alienated from God. God not only reached down from His heavenly glory to touch humanity. He left behind the glories of heaven and came to dwell with us on earth. Leaving the glories of heaven behind did not diminish the nature of the second person of the Divine Trinity. The divine and human natures were joined in a wonderful marriage of the two becoming one. We profess in the Creed that Jesus is fully human and fully divine. Jesus thus raises up the fallen nature of humanity that we may again share in the divine life of God.

This marriage of the divine and human, first manifested in the incarnation of the Son of God, is actualized in the Sacrament of Baptism. When parents, godparents and the community request the baptism of a child they are embracing the gift God lovingly bestows upon those He wishes to call His sons and daughters in Christ. To embrace this marriage between the human and the divine, we must be actively involved in our relationship with God. If we are raised from being simply human to being human and divine we must embrace our divinity, our Godliness. The only way to embrace our Godliness is to experience God in our life. We must seek God. In our relationship with God we must come to know, love and serve God in this life. God has revealed Himself to us in Jesus Christ. He has revealed Himself to us through His divinely inspired scriptures, the Bible. He has revealed Himself to us in the lived experience of the Church. We must actively seek to know the Lord. To come to love Him in this life and be with Him forever in the next.
