

#### A STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

"Disciples are followers, not wanderers and not meanderers bumping along with no direction. Followers are those that can see the path, hear the voice, notice the signposts, and recognize the one who goes before us.

Non-perishable food and grocery items are being collected for the Horseheads Food Pantry this month.


The Horseheads Food Pantry is in need of all food items. For your convenience, please place all donations in the cart located across from the bulletin board.
