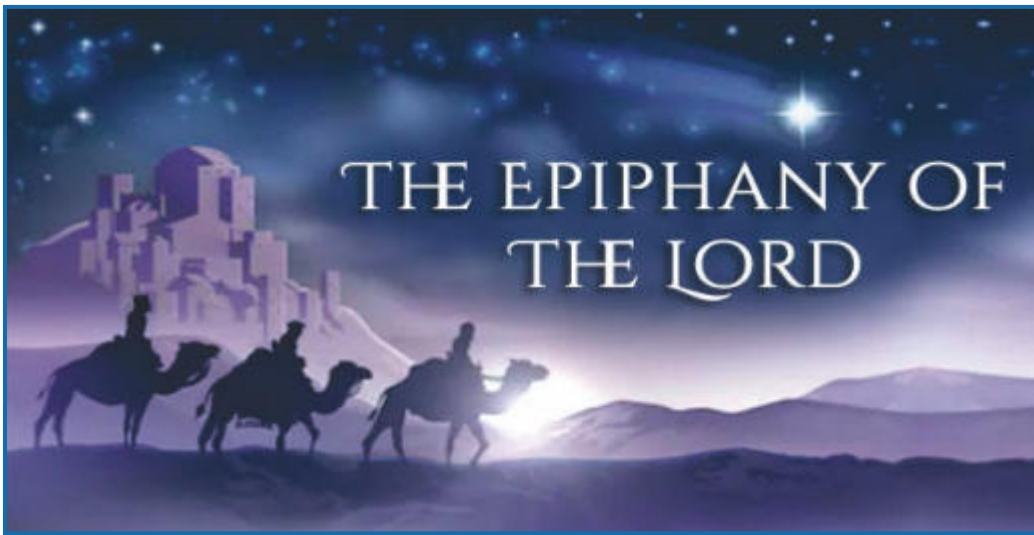

The Case for Jesus

Nowadays, skepticism about Jesus and His church are everywhere, and it's spreading fast. For well over a hundred years, critics have questioned the historical truth of the Gospels, claiming that they were originally anonymous. 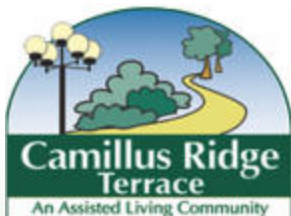
