# Joseph's Workbench

The time between Christmas and the Baptism of the Lord, this Sunday, is known as Christmastide, it includes the “12 days of Christmas” and the days after New Year’s Day. It is a time to take stock and relax a bit after the hectic holidays. I did this by going and spending time with my friend, Fr. Don Bourgeois, a retired priest from Binghamton who now lives at his childhood home in the Albany area. I’d hoped to see some museums, only to arrive in town and find out the museums were closed until the day, Wednesday, that I had to return to Camillus!

Instead, we went to the movies. I convinced Fr. Don to see the “Spiderman, Far from Home” movie with me because it is the number one movie right now. I loved it, he hated it. I had not realized that the movie requires some knowledge of all the other Spiderman movies. Fr. Don had seen only one previous movie and was completely lost!

This reminds me of faith. Much of the Christian faith includes “seeing the previous movies,” or knowing about things like God, sin, the Bible, and who Jesus is or what he said and did. If we have someone who does not believe, or has fallen away from the faith, we should not presume they know all these things. Sharing our faith also means sharing why we believe.

Which brings me to the second movie Fr. Don and I saw on my visit. “American Underdog” is the story of Kurt Warner, a famous football player. It is about his journey to a professional career in the NFL. He did not have the usual smooth ride of college football to the NFL draft and then a professional career. From stocking supermarket shelves to constant rejection by pro teams, to his love for a single mom with two kids, one a blind boy with intellectual disability, Kurt Warner had a rough time.

It’s an uplifting story, especially showing how all these challenges caused Warner to turn towards God. It has a happy ending, but bring your Kleenex, it’s a very moving movie. Fr. Don and I both loved it. I recommend it for everyone.

The most powerful way God reaches us is when his grace reaches us when we are up against it, struggling to keep going. That is when the witness of other people of faith going through the same things can be used by God to open up hearts to him.

“American Underdog” is mostly about football and its challenges with great lessons on the discipline, mental and physical, needed to make it in the game. The story of faith in the movie is not heavy handed and emerges from Warner’s real struggles and joys.

Christmastide brings us from holidays to “ordinary time,” we need to see God at work in both the extraordinary and the ordinary. Welcome to ordinary life, God is there too!

## The Case for Jesus Book/Bible study, Monday evenings, leading up to lent!

Nowadays, skepticism about Jesus and His church are everywhere, and it's spreading fast. For well over a hundred years, critics have questioned the historical truth of the Gospels, claiming that they were originally anonymous. In this amazing book Dr. Brant Pitre goes back to the sources—the biblical and historical evidence for Christ—in order to explore topics that are at the very heart of Christianity:

- Were the four Gospels anonymous?
- Are the Gospels folklore or biographies?
- Were the four Gospels written too late to be reliable?
- Did Jesus claim to be God?
- Did Jesus fulfill the Jewish prophecies of the Messiah?
- Why was Jesus crucified?
- What is the evidence for the Resurrection?

Above all, Dr. Pitre shows how the divine claims of Jesus can only be understood by putting them in their ancient Jewish context.
