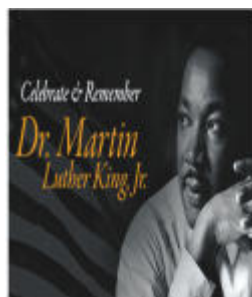

# Joseph's Workbench

**Formed.org** is the new resource we as a parish have subscribed to. I decided to take a tour and look at some of the many resources that are available. I was impressed. To subscribe you simply need to go to Formed.org on your computer, phone, or tablet and subscribe. To do this, you enter in our church (this is best done by putting in our parish zip code, 13031, then click on our church name), you then enter in your e-mail and you are subscribed. All the content is free and included in our parish subscription. You can also watch the content on your ROKU television or your ANDROID television, you simply click on the app on your television app store after having subscribed online and follow the activation instructions.

I was very impressed by the content. I watched "Daily Reflections" with Dr. Tim Gray. I may check that out before preaching at daily Mass! It's just a few minutes of reflection on the daily readings. I also watched "The Search" a series about the meaning of life (I only watched the first episode), it is compelling about how we all look for happiness but never quite find it. I will watch the rest of the series. I also watched the introduction to a series on the Eucharist, that impressed me too.

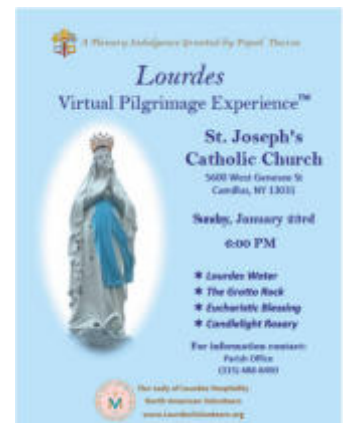
There are dozens of these interesting programs, some especially for children, including audio series and podcasts you can listen to on the app on your phone. Please give it a try.

### It's not too late... The Case for Jesus Book/Bible study, Monday evenings, leading up to lent!

Nowadays, skepticism about Jesus and His church are everywhere, and it's spreading fast. For well over a hundred years, critics have questioned the historical truth of the Gospels, claiming that they were originally anonymous. In this amazing book Dr. Brant Pitre goes back to the sources—the biblical and historical evidence for Christ—in order to explore topics that are at the very heart of Christianity:

- Were the four Gospels anonymous?
- Are the Gospels folklore or biographies?
- Were the four Gospels written too late to be reliable?
- Did Jesus claim to be God?
- Did Jesus fulfill the Jewish prophecies of the Messiah?
- Why was Jesus crucified?
- What is the evidence for the Resurrection?

Above all, Dr. Pitre shows how the divine claims of Jesus can only be understood by putting them in their ancient Jewish context.

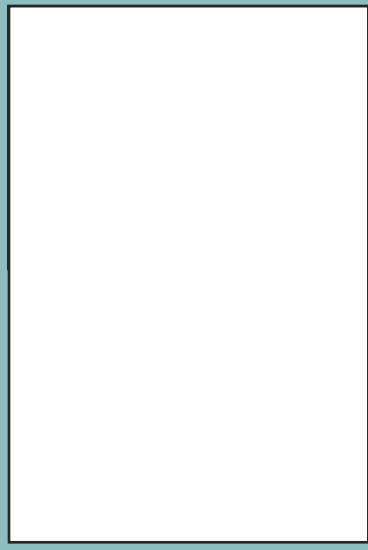
