



Charitable Contributions Directly from IRA are Tax Exempt

As part of the PATH ACT of 2015, each year, any person who is at least 70 1/2 years of age may make direct charitable contributions of up to \$100,000 from an IRA without having to report that IRA distribution as taxable income on their federal income tax return. Those annual IRA distributions are normally referred to as required minimum distributions (RMD).
