Well....no longer!

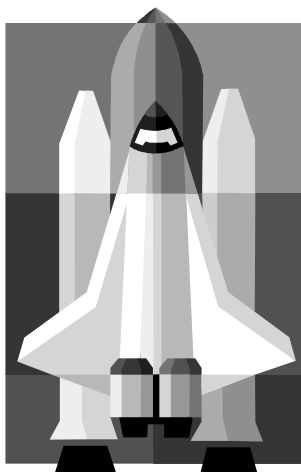

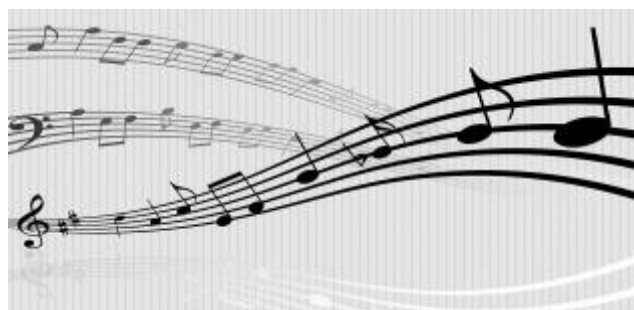
Parish Prayer List
