

The Grief Survivors support group allows individuals to explore their feelings, find support from individuals experiencing similar feelings, and move through the grieving process. Each session is unique, offering a blend of discussion, activities, and video presentations. Fellowship is a large part of the process and there is time for that as well. Individuals are invited to share during the discussions, but there is no pressure to do so. *The program is offered every other Tuesday from 6:00 to 7:30 PM*. Upcoming meetings are December 21st, January 5th and January 19th.
