

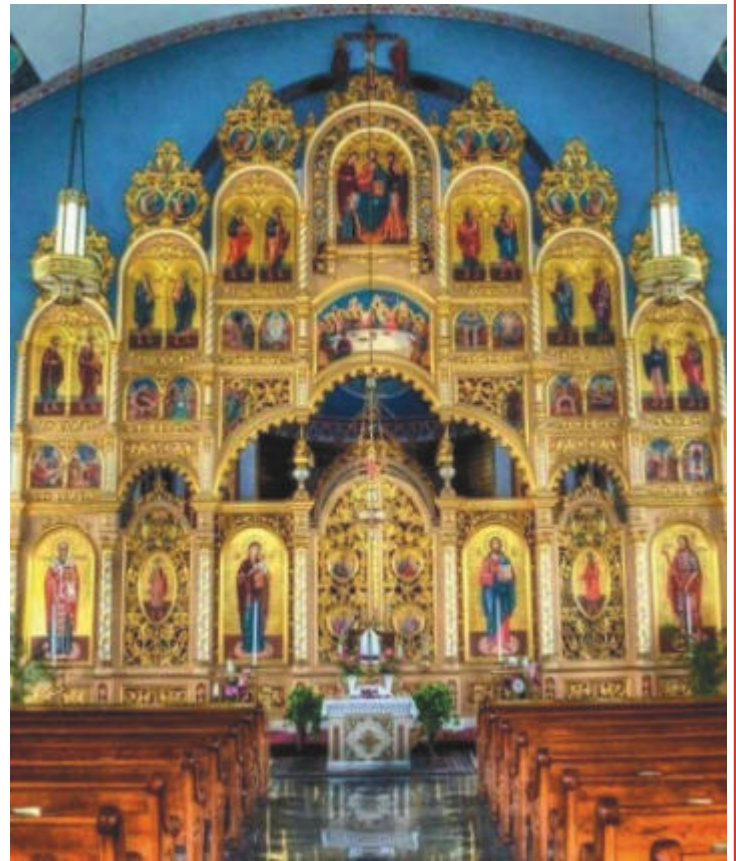

Second Sorrow: *The Poverty of Jesus' birth (Luke 2:7)*
