



On Monday, I will be at St. Matthew in the Reconciliation Room from 10:00am to 1:30pm and again from 3:00pm to 6:30pm.

On Tuesday, I will be at St. Mary's in the sacristy. I will have both a kneeler and also two chairs, so that people who may wish to confess anonymously or face-to-face, may have their choice. I would ask that people come into the sacristy by the door in the sanctuary. Again, the times will be from 10:00am to 1:30pm and from 3:00pm to 6:30pm.

I hope that this will be advantageous for our people. If you have any other suggestions that might make reconciliation more accessible, I would be willing to hear them.



Celebrating a Quarter Century of Mentoring in Livingston County

HOPE Youth Mentoring (Helping One Person Excel) was created in August of 1997 and since then, has matched hundreds of young people in Livingston County with mentors. The boys and girls who are re-

ferred to the program are between the ages of 6-16 and in need of extra support. These youth are experiencing difficulties at home, at school or in the community.

We would like to make a special appeal to the members of our Faith Community. Recently we have gotten several referrals from the Conesus, Livonia, Geneseo and Avon areas. We hope to find some folks willing to become Mentors for these youth. You don't need special skills to be a mentor, you only need to "share what you know." Our program provides you the training, ongoing support, and organized group activities throughout the year.


