PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on June 19, 2020, The Roman Catholic Diocese of Syracuse, New York, ("Diocese") filed for protection under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

The Bankruptcy Court has established April 15, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "Bar Date").

If you have a claim against the Diocese including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date with Stretto, the appointed Claims Agent.



THE LITURGY OF THE WORD



Dear Parishioners,

For decades, Saint Rose of Lima Church has served an important role in the life of Catholics who live in and around the North Syracuse area. The generosity of our parishioners has provided for the needs of the church, school and community in so many ways.

Shortly after my arrival at Saint Rose of Lima as your pastor, with the assistance of our Pastoral Council and Parish Trustees, I conducted a review of our buildings and campus grounds. As a result of that review, it was clear that the church building and basement hall had significant need of repair.

To that effect, after receiving several requests for proposal from respected architects, I engaged the services of Mr. Daniel Manning, Architect, PLLC, to conduct an onsite analysis of the church and hall. As part of that analysis, I directed Mr. Manning to provide me with a long-range plan for the improvement and upkeep of the church and grounds.

Mr. Manning's written analysis made the following recommendations for the safety and well-being of our parishioners and church building:

- replace the current church roofing (which is leaking and failing);
- build a new gathering space with elevator;
- update the HVAC system to bring our heating/air-conditioning up to maximum efficiency;
- replace interior and exterior doors, which are not functioning properly;
- restore the sanctuary, pews and organ;
- improve the flooring;
- update the church lighting;
- repaint the interior of the church and repair the stained-glass windows;
- improve handicapped parking and access to the church and church hall (basement);
- replace windows in the church hall and improve the space for more efficient use

In an effort to help us provide for the present and prepare for the future, I was asked, at the recommendation of our Pastoral Council and Parish Trustees, to employ the expertise of John Kearns and Associates to assist us with a capital campaign to raise the funds needed to carry out this important and needed project. They have assisted many other parishes in the diocese with projects similar to ours.

I will provide more information about the campaign in the near future. I trust that you will recognize that this work needs to be done to enhance our facilities for better worship and community building. All money raised for this initiative will remain at St. Rose of Lima and is for the exclusive needs of our parish.

In the meantime, I ask you to pray with me, our Pastoral Council and Trustees, for the Holy Spirit's guidance and for the intercession of Saint Rose of Lima for this ambitious project.
