Clustering Part Five: Embracing the Future with Hope

I am proposing a call to Stewardship in our parishes and cluster that ***"fosters a spirit of gratitude for God's blessings and to encourage gifts of time, talent, and treasure."*** "Like good stewards of the manifold grace of God, serve one another with whatever gifts each of you have received." (1 Peter 4:10). The U.S. Catholic Bishops have defined a Christian steward as "one who receives God's gifts gracefully, cultivates them responsibly and shares them lovingly in justice with others, and returns them abundantly to the Lord." We pledge our time, our talent, and our treasure to make our cluster, healthy and vibrant parishes of St. Alphonsus, Holy Family, Sacred Heart and St. Ann, places where everyone is welcomed to worship the one, true God. As a Cluster Community committed to Stewardship of TIME, TALENT AND TREASURE, we are all asked to reflect prayerfully on the importance of God in our lives, acknowledging the many gifts and blessings we have been given. We pray, reflect, evaluate, and plan our commitment to our parishes. We look forward with hope to hearing the call God's guidance in our lives to response to the many needs and opportunities in his Church.

The Parishes Finance Council is an integral part of the Stewardship responsibilities of each parish. An active, well-formed Parish Finance Council is a key element for promoting the financial health of a parish, assuring accountability and assisting the pastor and the Regional Finance Director with their temporal responsibilities. Canon 537 introduces the Parish Finance Council as a mandated body having an advisory and consultative role with the pastor. *"Each parish is to have a finance council which is regulated by universal law as well as by norms issued by the diocesan bishop; in this council the Christian faithful, selected according to the same norms, aid the pastor in the administration of parish goods."* The primary purpose of the Finance Council is to provide assistance and guidance to the Pastor and the Regional Finance Director in achieving the fiscally and managerially responsible stewardship of the Parish's material goods and financial resources. The Finance Council assists the Pastor and the Regional Finance director in a consultative capacity only. The Pastor is responsible for parish policy. While the Parish Finance Council does not have decision making authority, consultation is at the heart of the decision-making process – sharing information, listening, contributing to the discussion, and promoting consensus. The Finance Council works closely with the pastor and the Regional Finance Director, who are accountable to the bishop for the administration and stewardship of the temporal goods of the parishes and cluster. In order to be effective in their responsibilities as members of the Parish Finance Council, members should have a love for the Church and its mission and develop a thorough understanding of the parish's mission, goals, people and other resources. The members should have knowledge of diocesan statutes and policies regarding temporal issues and other financial matters. It is the Regional Finance Directors responsibility to give the members appropriate background and enrichment so they are able to carry out their duties. **The major responsibilities are:**

1. The Finance Council should review the parish annual budget of income and expenditure (Canon 1283.3). They should review the annual report on the parish for review of the diocesan finance committee (Canon 1287.1)
2. The Finance Council should review the communication of the Annual Financial Report to the parish community, as required by Canon 1287.2. Understandable, regular and complete communication to parishioners is a key responsibility of the pastor and an important area for the Parish Finance Council to assist. Communication keeps parishioners informed of the parish's condition, its priorities, its needs, and progress on previously announced initiatives.

3. The Finance Council shall regularly review periodic (at least quarterly) financial reports – balance sheet, income statements, comparisons to budget as well as prior year results and cash flow analysis, and also long-range financial planning.

4. The Finance Council will consult with the Building and Grounds Committee, Pastor and Regional Finance Director on the construction or renovation of parish facilities, and rental agreements. The Finance Council and the Building and Grounds assists the pastor in planning for repair, replacement, or service of property and equipment to ensure that the parish buildings and property are adequately maintained. The Finance Committee reviews maintenance and utility costs seeking to minimize costs through preventative maintenance, energy conservation, and the implementation of risk management programs and recommendations.

5. The Finance Council will assess effectiveness of existing fund-raising programs and recommend new programs or changes to existing programs if revenues are insufficient. Support parish and diocesan stewardship programs.

6. The Finance Council will ensure that proper internal controls and procedures are in place so that cash and other resources are used for their intended purposes. Also, ensure familiarity with Diocesan financial requirements, policies, and procedures.

I encourage you to continue forward in hope. Christ tells us, "Take *courage! It is I. Do not be afraid.*" (**Mark 6:50**). Look to your faith as we face all the challenges ahead of us. Know that the Lord has blessed these communities abundantly throughout the years and will continue to do so. I thank all Finance Council members in all our three parishes for this crucial ministry and stewardship. Please keep members of these councils in your prayers. Fr. John

Faith Formation

This coming year over 100 of our young people will receive either the sacraments of 1st Penance/Eucharist or Confirmation. We are blessed to have great preparation programs for each of these sacraments. Students in 2nd grade who were enrolled in a Faith Formation program or Catholic School in 1st grade and are enrolled in a Faith Formation program or Catholic School for 2nd grade, are invited to begin their journey to the reception of the Sacraments of 1st Penance and 1st Communion. The formation for these sacraments is in addition to regular Faith Formation classes in the parish or Catholic School. We use *Blessed* by Dynamic Catholic. Generally, we meet once a month in a large group gathering that includes parent with child for a lesson, and then a lesson is completed at home. Prior to the reception of the sacrament parent and child attend a morning retreat where we focus on the reception of the sacrament. There will be an orientation/registration meeting for 1st Penance on Wednesday September 18.
