**In the Parish of Saints John and Andrew, note the following which is subject to change:**

- ◆ Parishioners are not required to pre-register for Mass.
- ◆ Parishioners who are **fully vaccinated** are not required to wear a face mask at Mass.
- ◆ Parishioners who are **fully vaccinated** and prefer to continue wearing face masks and social distance are free to do so.
- ◆ Those who are **not fully vaccinated** are to wear a face mask at Mass and should observe social distancing of 6 feet from individuals not in their household.
- ◆ Those who are **not fully vaccinated** are to sit in the designated area where there is signage.
- ◆ Please continue to bring your own liquid sanitizer to use before receiving Holy Eucharist.
- ◆ There is still no physical contact during the Sign of Peace.
- ◆ Eucharistic Adoration will remain in the chapel on Wednesday.
- ◆ We rely on the goodness and honesty of our parishioners to follow State guidelines regarding those fully vaccinated and unvaccinated.

**HOPE APPEAL 2020**

You may recall 2020 HOPE Appeal. Due to the generosity of those parishioners able to contribute, we were \$8,390.90 over our goal. Because we were in the pandemic, HOPE Appeal informed the parishes of our Diocese that 100% of the overage would be returned. Two weeks ago, we received a check for \$8,390.90. ### Support the Hyde Amendment and Oppose Taxpayer Funding for Abortions

Since 1976 the Hyde amendment and similar federal laws have protected federal taxpayers from being forced to pay for elective abortions. A majority of Americans agree with the Hyde amendment and oppose taxpayer funding for abortions. However, this week, the United States House of Representatives Committee on Appropriations will begin to mark-up appropriations bills that currently exclude language similar to the Hyde amendment that prevents federal taxpayer funding for abortions. Archbishop Joseph F. Naumann, chairman of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) Committee on Pro-Life Activities and Bishop David J. Malloy, chairman of the USCCB Committee on International Justice and Peace, issued a statement that can be read at:

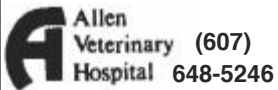

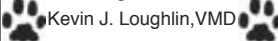

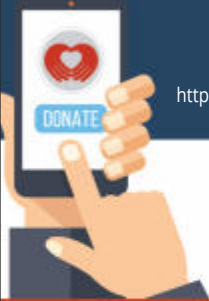
