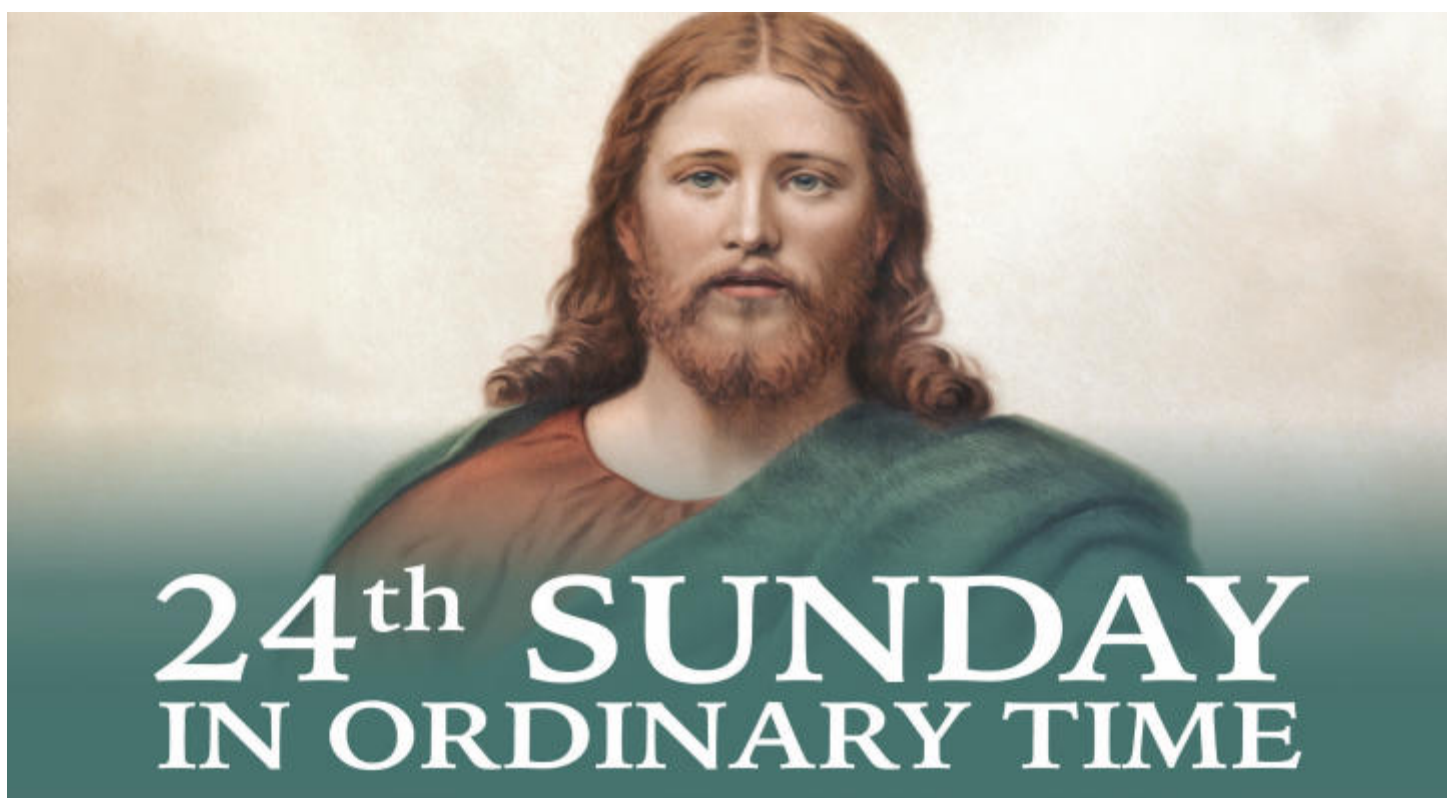

In the Parish of Saints John and Andrew, note the following which is subject to change:

- ◆ Parishioners are not required to pre-register for Mass.
- ◆ Parishioners who are **fully vaccinated** are not required to wear a face mask at Mass.
- ◆ Parishioners who are **fully vaccinated** and prefer to continue wearing face masks and social distance are free to do so.
- ◆ Those who are **not fully vaccinated** are to wear a face mask at Mass and should observe social distancing of 6 feet from individuals not in their household.
- ◆ Those who are **not fully vaccinated** are to sit in the designated area where there is signage.
- ◆ **Please continue to bring your own liquid sanitizer to use before receiving Holy Eucharist.**
- ◆ There is still no physical contact during the Sign of Peace.
- ◆ Eucharistic Adoration will remain in the chapel on Wednesday.
- ◆ We rely on the goodness and honesty of our parishioners to follow State guidelines regarding those fully vaccinated and unvaccinated.

Individuals and families living in Broome County will have the opportunity to sign-up for a Thanksgiving basket. Baskets will include all the items needed for a wonderful holiday meal.

Sign-ups for baskets will take place **September 7th through October 15th, 2021**. Sign-ups will be held by calling the **United Way 211 phone number (dial 2 1 1)** from **Monday - Friday 8AM to 5PM** beginning the Tuesday after Labor Day.

Each household will receive a confirmation number from 211. The confirmation number will be needed to pick up the basket. One Thanksgiving basket will be provided per household. Please have information on hand for every person within the household prior to making the 211 call.

All families signed-up for a basket will receive a phone call or mailed document 1 to 2 weeks prior to Thanksgiving Day. This will provide information on date, time and location of the basket pick up. Families should expect to pick up their baskets the weekend of November 19th - November 21st, 2021.

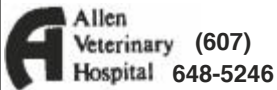

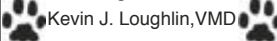
