

As we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, it is a good time to reflect on the Sacrament of Baptism, and on the gift of our own Baptism.

Baptism is not just a celebration, it actually accomplishes the things that it celebrates. It *does* something. The effects of Baptism are "the forgiveness of original sin and all personal sins, [and] birth into the new life by which man becomes an adoptive son of the Father, a member of Christ and a temple of the Holy Spirit. By this very fact the person baptized is incorporated into the Church, the Body of Christ, and made a sharer in the priesthood of Christ." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1279) Baptism leaves a permanent imprint on the soul of the person who receives it, meaning that Baptism can never be undone, and can never be repeated.

Baptism is so important that in the case of need – such as when there is a danger of imminent death – any person can, and sometimes must, baptize. Priests and Deacons are the ordinary ministers, but every person is an extraordinary minister if they have to be. Even people who aren't even Christians themselves can baptize someone, as long as they intend to "do what the Church does."

For this reason, the Church teaches that all Christians should know how to baptize, just in case there is a need in an emergency. The simplest form of Baptism is just to say, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" while pouring ordinary water on the person's head. If there were enough time, it would be good to pray the Creed before and the Our Father after, but the pouring of water and the proper words are all that is strictly necessary. If this is done, it should be reported to the local parish to be recorded, and if the person survives, they would come to the Church to take part in the other elements of the celebration that couldn't be included at the time.

Christ Himself testified to the great importance of Baptism when He ordered us to celebrate it, saying, after his resurrection, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." (Matthew 28:19-20)
