

OUR LORD AT A WEDDING FEAST

Introducing the Gospel of St. John, one can generally say it opens with a wedding feast at Cana in Galilee, a banquet where our Lord performed His first miracle, changing water into wine. We also see that St. John closes his Gospel with another wedding feast, the Last Supper "Wedding Feast of the Lamb". There, our Lord changes bread and wine into His Body and Blood. The fact that St. John brackets his Gospel with these two weddings feasts and their miracles is of divine revelation.

The Gospel of John's story at Cana reveals to us one of the events that came to pass to manifest to us that the promise of God the Father was being fulfilled in the fullness of time. A few days ago, we celebrated the Baptism of the Lord Jesus. We heard of that special moment, when the voice of God the Father was heard from Heaven and the Holy Spirit descended upon Jesus in the form of a dove, marking the beginning of the public ministry of Jesus Christ on earth.

Up until then, Jesus had not done anything extraordinary that pointed out at His Divinity. But at the Wedding of Cana, it was different. That was when Jesus performed His first public miracle. By transforming the element of water into wine, He executed an act that cannot be matched by any human being.

The presence of Jesus at Cana blesses the meaning and purpose of marriage. In marriage life what we see, is central to what God is all about in Christ's incarnation. Marriage is all about commitment and belonging. To His mother when He says: "My hour has not yet come" interpreters of scripture say it was none other than that "hour" or that time when, at the end of His life, we find Him at the Last Supper, find Him in agony in the Garden of Gethsemane followed by His death on the cross. This is the "hour" in which He says: "this is my body, take it; this is my blood, drink it". This is where our Lord is in an unbreakable union with his bride the Church, that nothing, not even sin or death, can overcome. I will love you no matter what. I am marrying you, and even if you crucify and put me to death, I will come back from the grave to love you, because nothing can make me not love you." The new and everlasting covenant is God's marriage to humanity.

The Wedding of Cana has been seen as a prophetic of the celebration of the Holy Mass. During the "Preparation of the Holy Gifts," the celebrant places a drop of water into the wine saying: "by the mystery of this water and wine may we come to share in the divinity of Christ, who humbled himself to share in our humanity." These words remind us of the Wedding of Cana.

Both the celebration of the Holy Mass and the Wedding of Cana consist of a great feast during which time the bride and bridegroom are present. Every time we participate in the celebration of the Holy Mass, in spirit, we witness the delight of the Heavenly Father who rejoices in His Bride, the Holy Church.

As St. John states in his first letter, the new life that we have received in Christ is of the godly seed. It is no wonder that God rejoices in His Bride of which we are living members. As the Lord God rejoices in His Holy Church, He also rejoices in each and every one of us.


