Synod 2021-2023

As some of you may have heard, several months ago, Pope Francis convoked a synod, which is a meeting of the whole Church, represented by Bishops from around the world, to give advice to the pope on a particular topic. The topic for this Synod is “For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission” In other words, the Holy Father has called for the Church to listen and reflect on the ways we are being called to accompany one another as we follow Christ together.

In his video introducing the diocesan phase of the Synod, Bishop Matano said, “We are a family with God as our Father, and the synod process is the journey of a family trying to better understand what is the foundation upon which our Church has been built, where Jesus Christ is cornerstone.”

The Synod called for by Pope Francis is not directly related to a separate event which has been planned by the bishops of the United States, a National Eucharistic Revival, which will take place over the next three years. (We will share more about this soon.) That said, the things we learn from listening to what people have to say as part of the Synod process can be a help in how we celebrate the Eucharistic revival.

The Synod is not just a strategy session or a team building exercise, it is meant to be a spiritual process, led by the Holy Spirit. It is not an arena for us to fight political battles, but a time to understand how we are being led together. Finally, and perhaps most important to keep in mind when listening to news reports, the Synod is not going to lead to any changes in Church teaching. It is about listening to people and learning how best we can accompany them on our common journey toward Jesus Christ, not about putting the Truth up to some kind of vote.

The diocesan phase of the synod is going on now, and we will be seeking input until March 31st. This is the time for listening to anyone who would like to contribute. There will be meetings of certain groups, but everyone is welcome to participate either individually or by forming a gathering of their own. There are ten different topics or themes, each with several questions, but there is no need to try to answer them all; it is best to stick to what speaks to you or your group, and what you feel called to share your thoughts about. We'd like to thank parishioners at St. Katharine Drexel for their generosity to the Macedon Community Christmas

Program. The many gift cards, angel tree gifts, food boxes, and volunteer help was much appreciated. 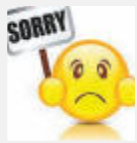
