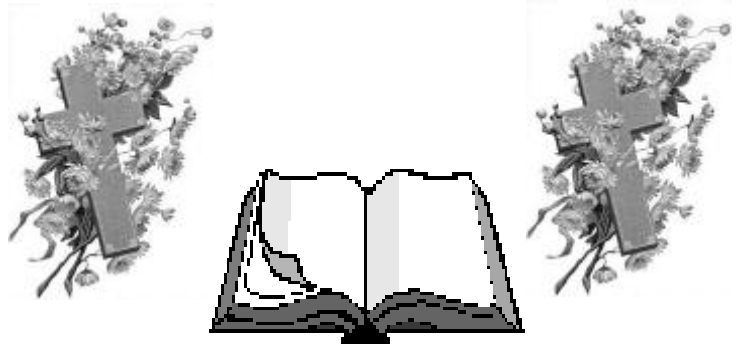

**Where do I park when I attend Mass at
